



⁴ Surely He took up our pain and bore our suffering, yet we considered Him punished by God, stricken by Him, and afflicted.



⁵ But He was pierced for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on Him, and by His wounds we are healed.

⁶ We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to our own way; and the Lord has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.

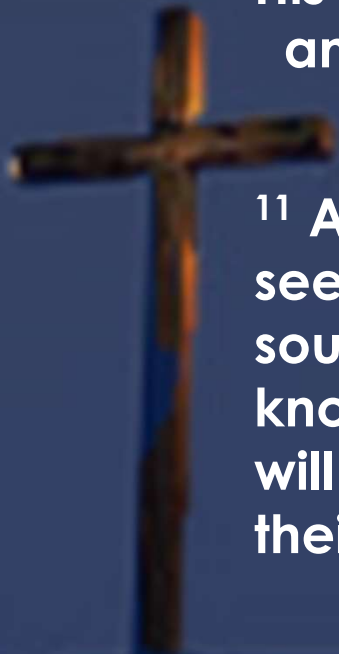
