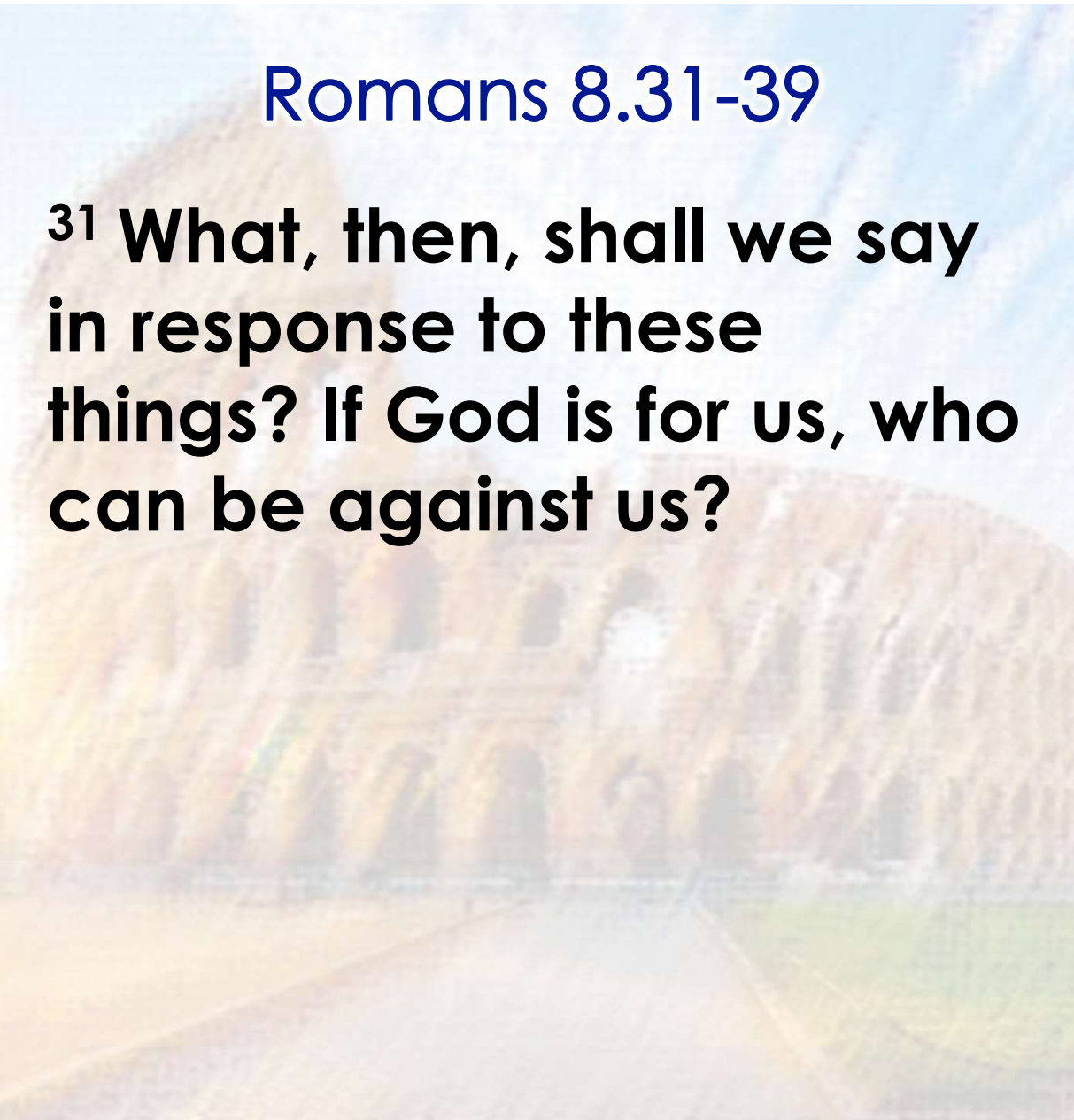

sword?**

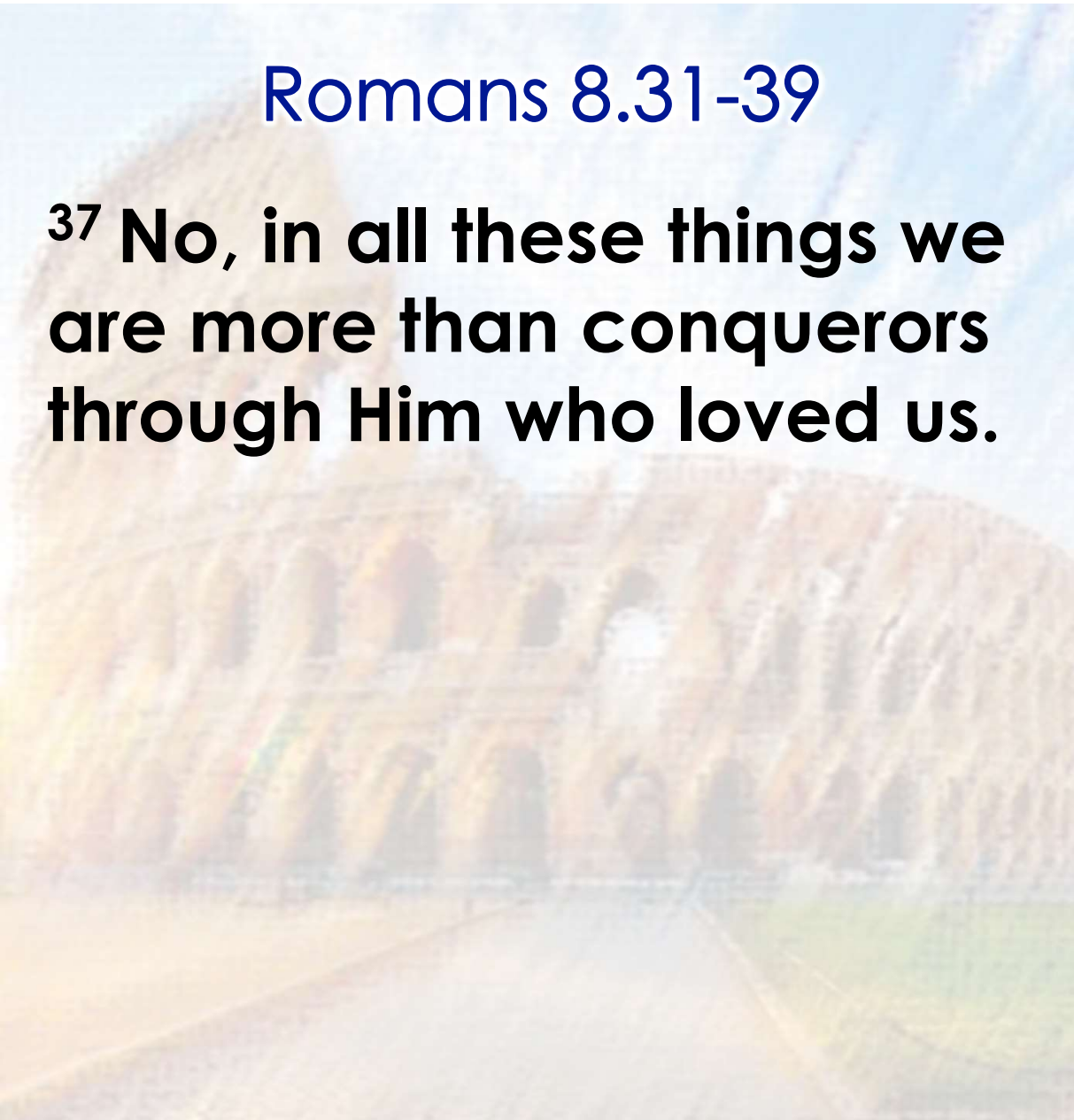
