**t** . . . . .

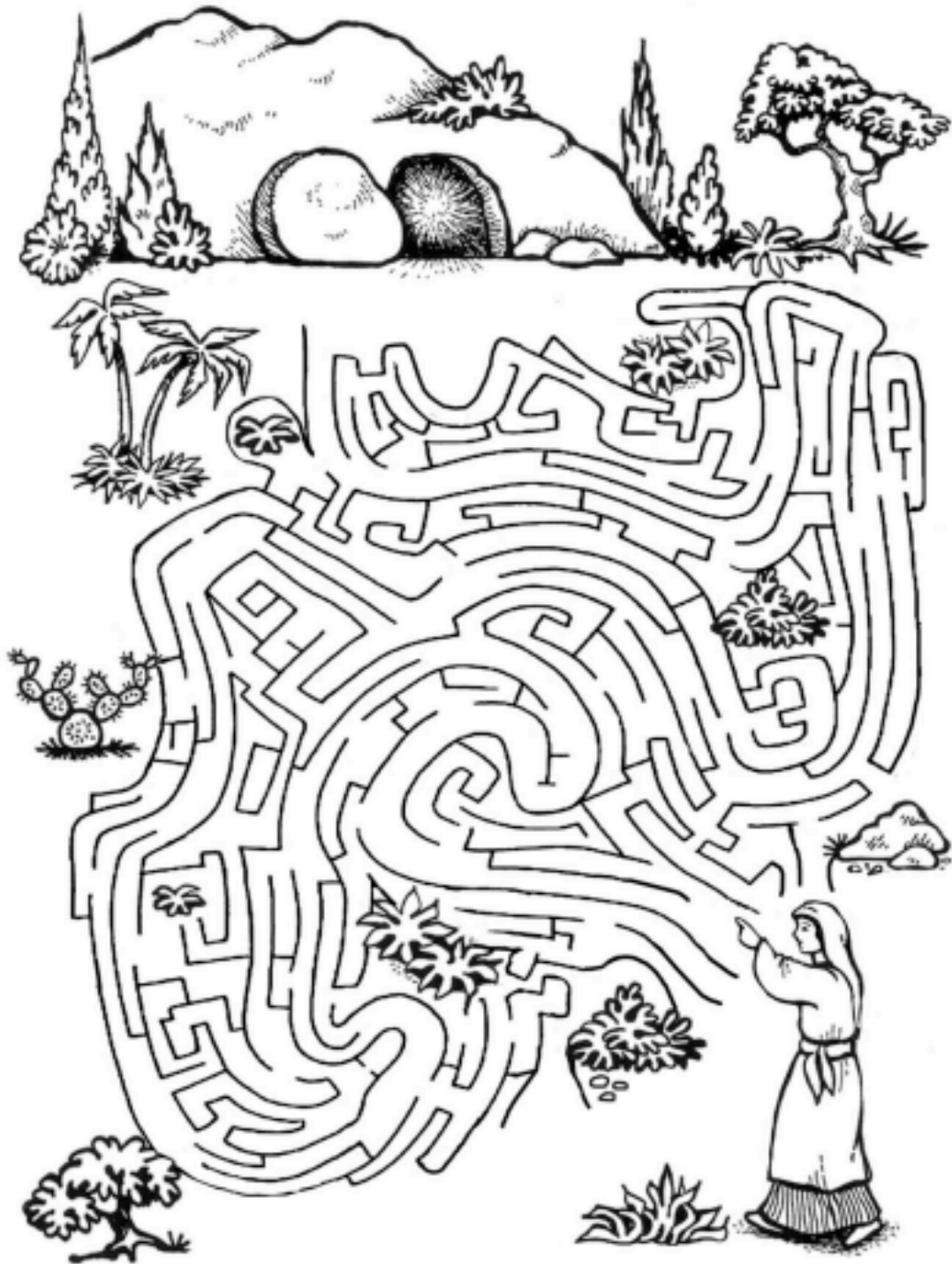
**o** . . . . .
