Last Sunday evening we learned about the first of these people: the apostle Paul.

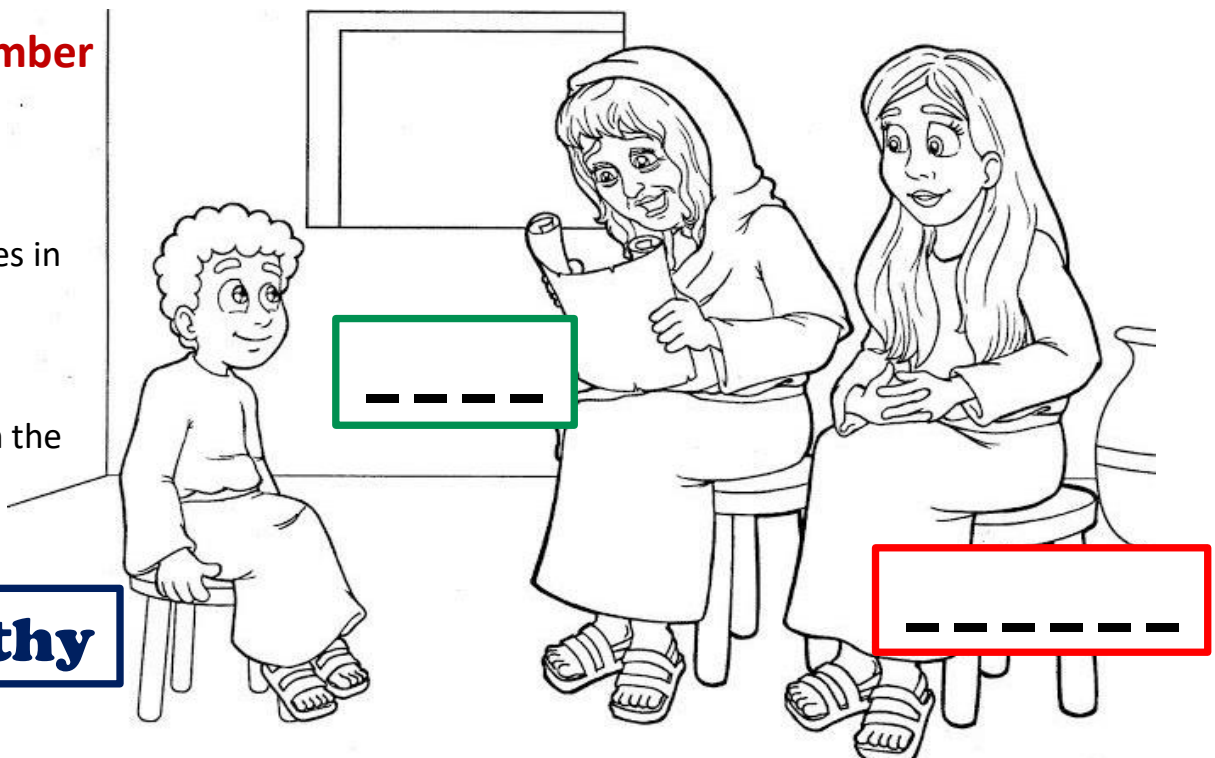
This week we're going to think about the other 2 people who are mentioned in the passage here.

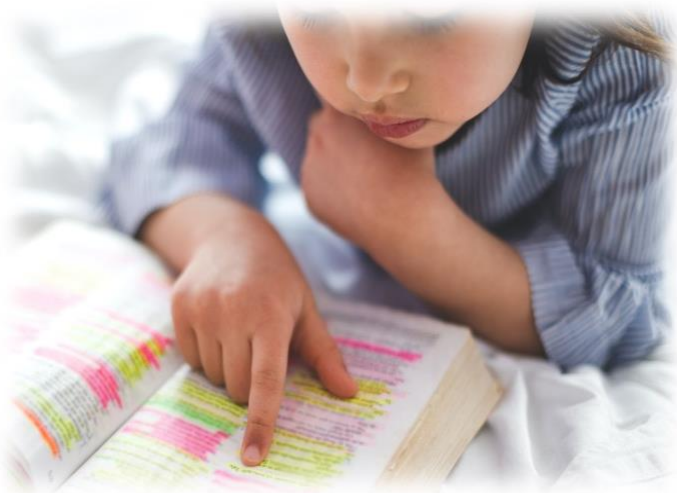

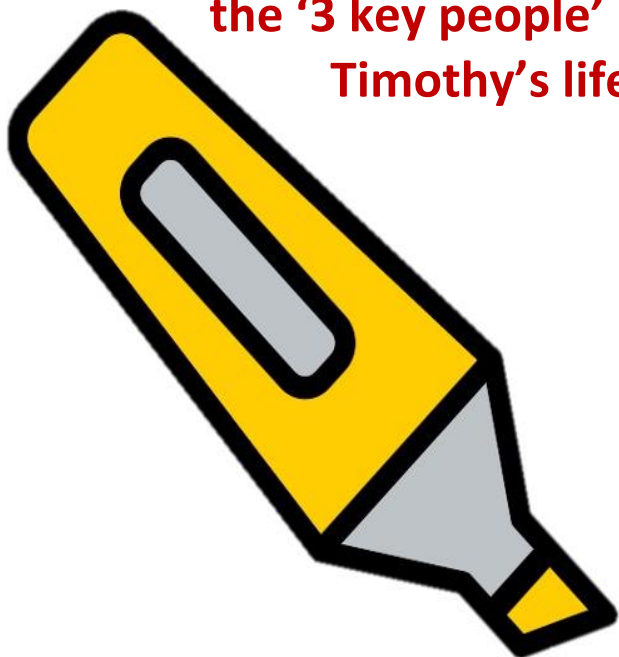

2 Tim.1.1-5

Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, in keeping with the promise of life that is in Christ Jesus,

² To Timothy, my dear son: Grace, mercy and peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord.

³ I thank God, whom I serve, as my ancestors did, with a clear conscience, as night and day I constantly remember you in my prayers. ⁴ Recalling your tears, I long to see you, so that I may be filled with joy. ⁵ I am reminded of your sincere faith, which first lived in your grandmother Lois and in your mother Eunice and, I am persuaded, now lives in you also.

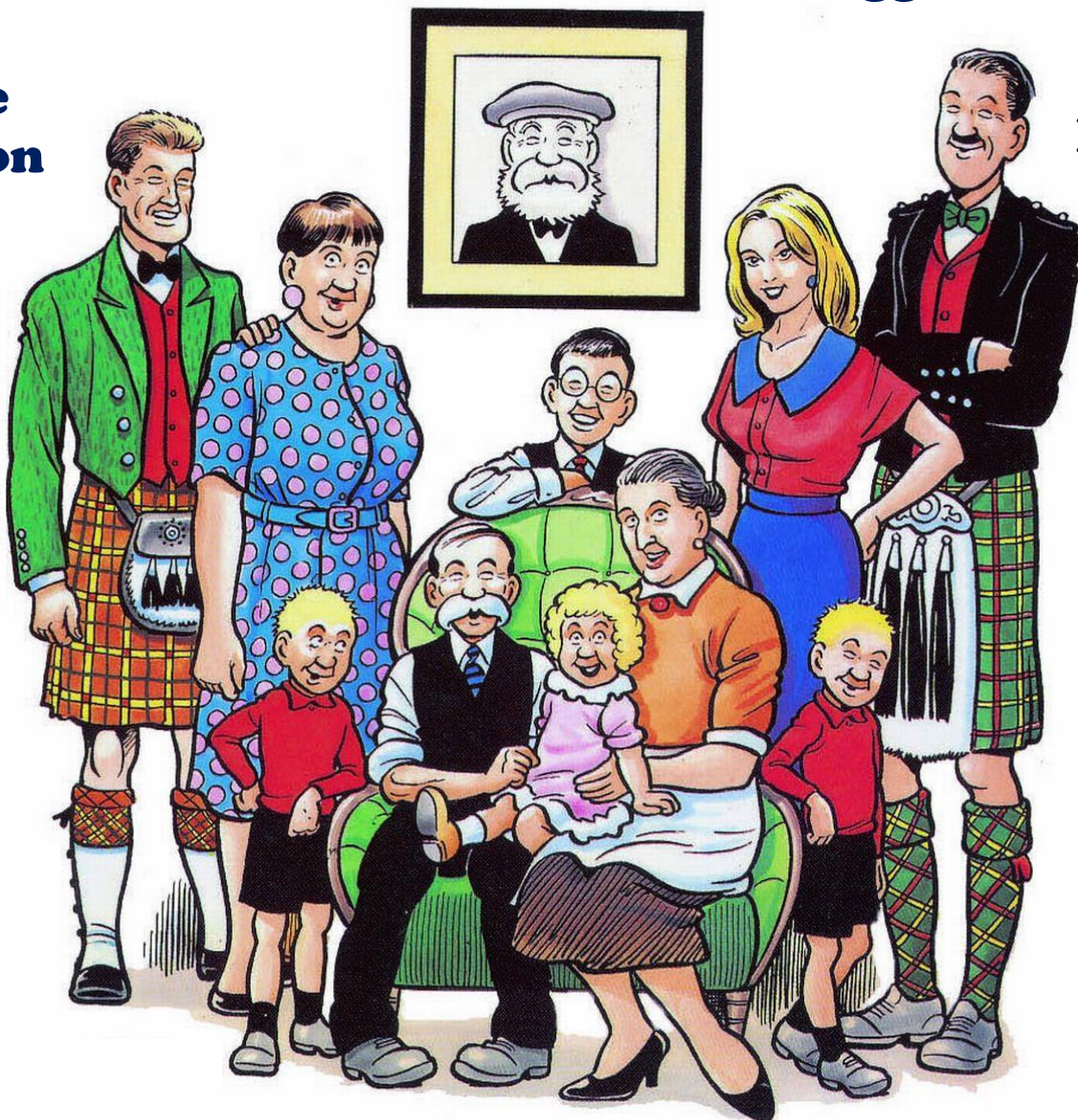

Help me to learn well from them about You, so that I can grow up to be someone You use to make others

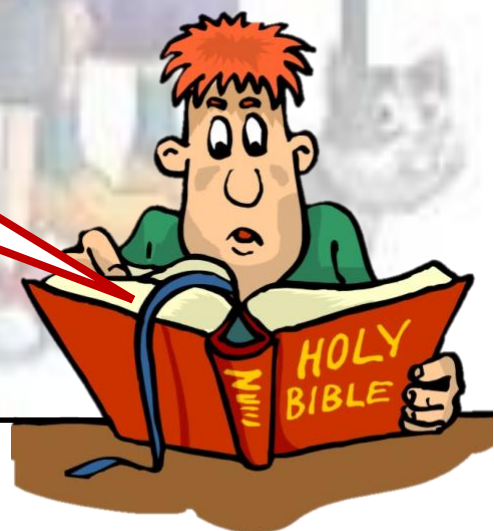

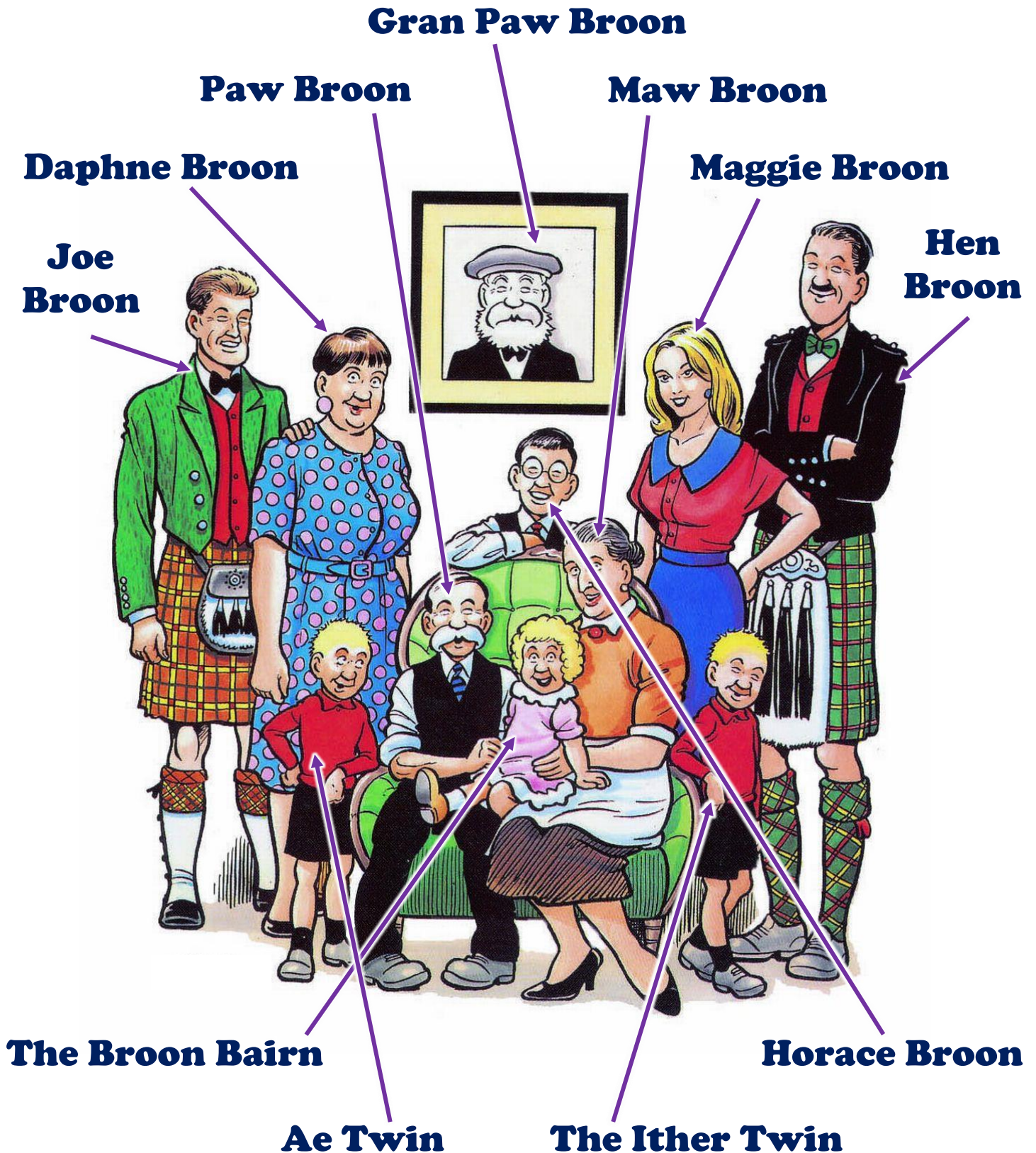
