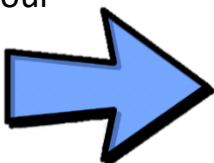

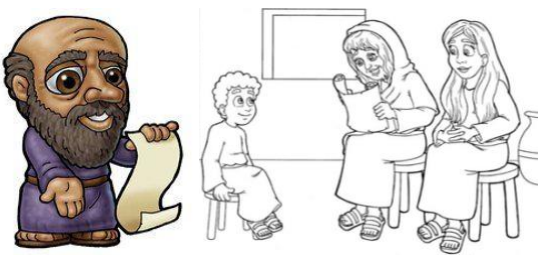


Here's today's Bible passage



God's good gift

Paul began his letter to Timothy by reminding him of **the 3 key people** who, more than any others, had helped him to know Jesus.



In the verses we'll think about today, he was reminding Timothy about **the gift of God** that He has given His people, the Holy Spirit.

Read

2 Tim.1.1-7

Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, in keeping with the promise of life that is in Christ Jesus,

² To Timothy, my dear son:

Grace, mercy and peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord.

³ I thank God, whom I serve, as my ancestors did, with a clear conscience, as night and day I constantly remember you in my prayers. ⁴ Recalling your tears, I long to see you, so that I may be filled with joy. ⁵ I am reminded of your sincere faith, which first lived in your grandmother Lois and in your mother Eunice and, I am persuaded, now lives in you also.

⁶ For this reason I remind you to fan into flame **the gift of God**, which is in you through the laying on of my hands.

⁷ For **the Spirit God gave us** does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline.

The Holy Spirit

The Holy Spirit is a 'person'.

This is what Jesus promised His disciples –

"I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you forever – the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept Him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you"

[John 14.16-17]

Jesus (who's God) was asking the Father (who's God) to give His people 'another helper' (someone exactly the same **?** as Jesus Himself) to be with them and in them, namely the Holy Spirit (who's God).



Confusing? A bit!

The Holy Spirit is God's gift to His people – and that means that if you've trusted in Jesus then you have Jesus Himself *with* you and actually *in* you, always.

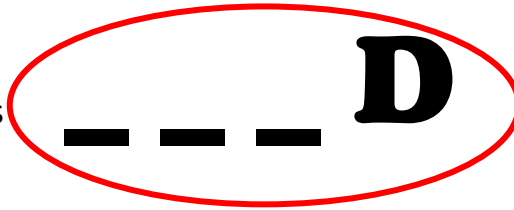


What does the Holy Spirit give us?

He started with a negative. The Holy Spirit does not make us timid.

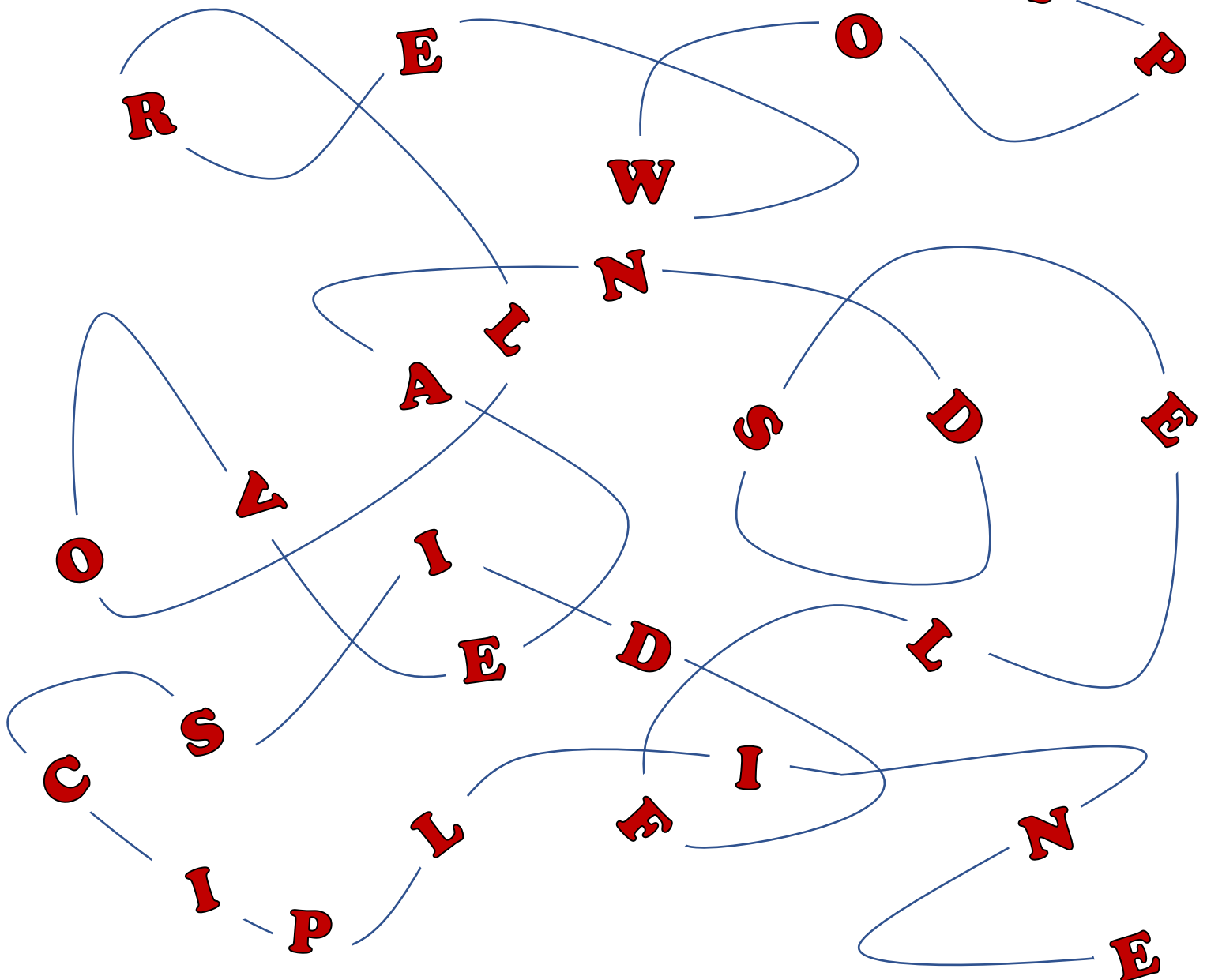

Thank You that You help me to know what it is truly to be



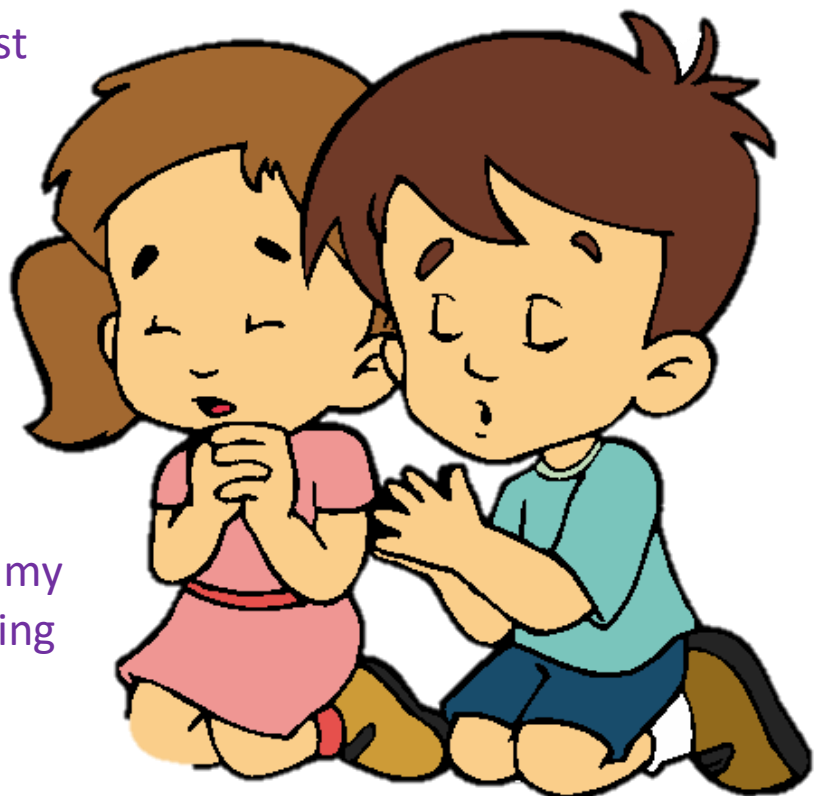
Thank You that You've come to live *in* everyone who trusts in You by giving us Your Holy Spirit. That's amazing!

Thank You, Jesus, for everything.

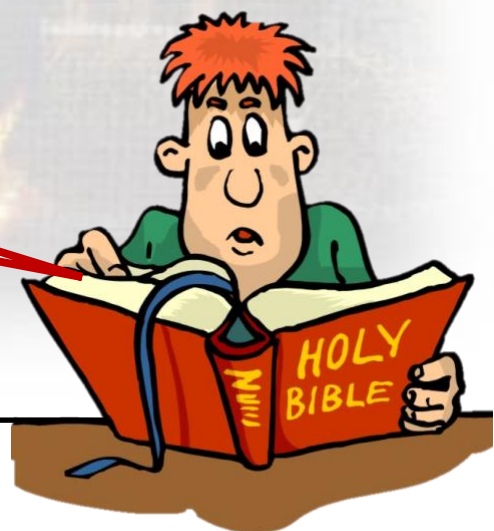

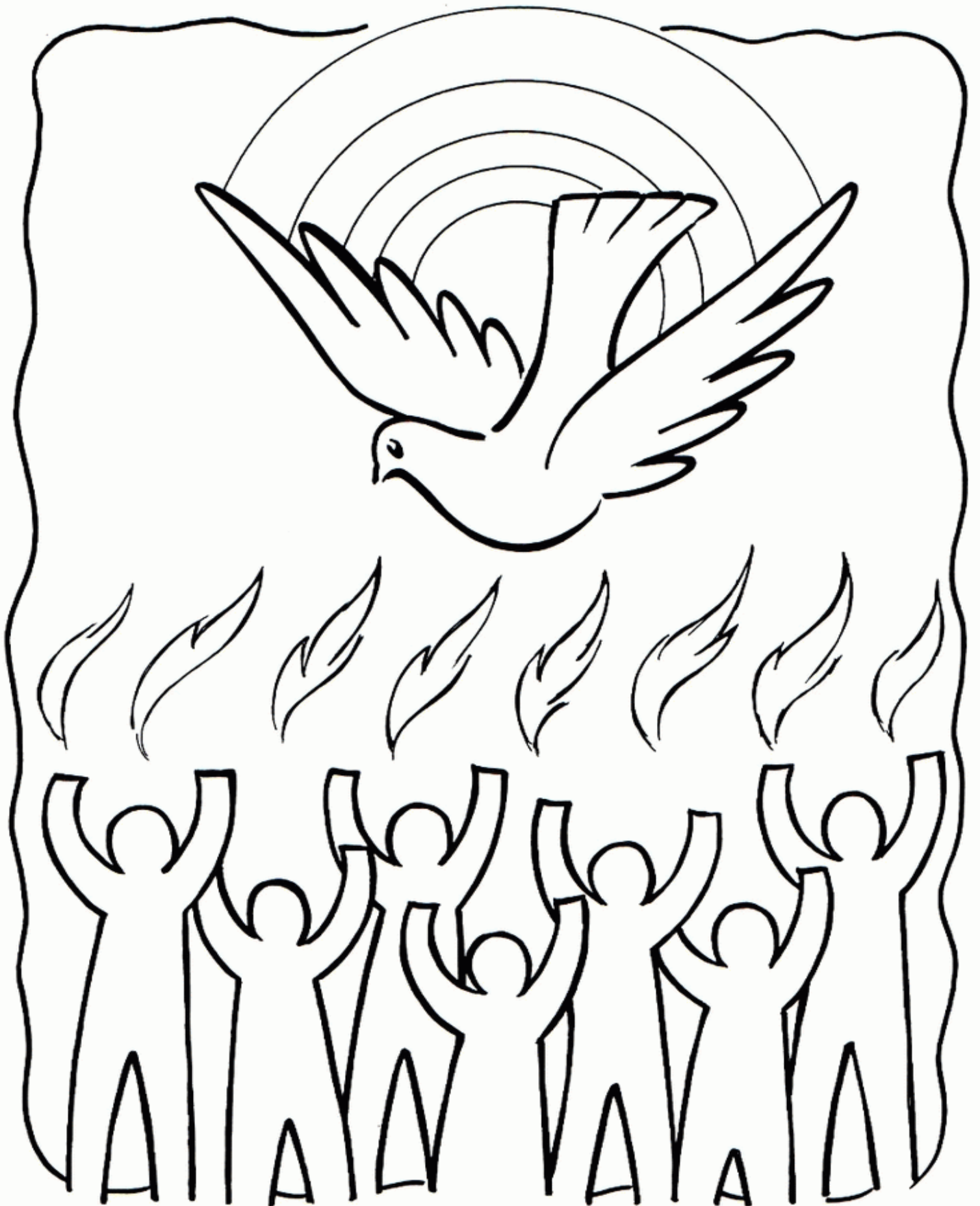

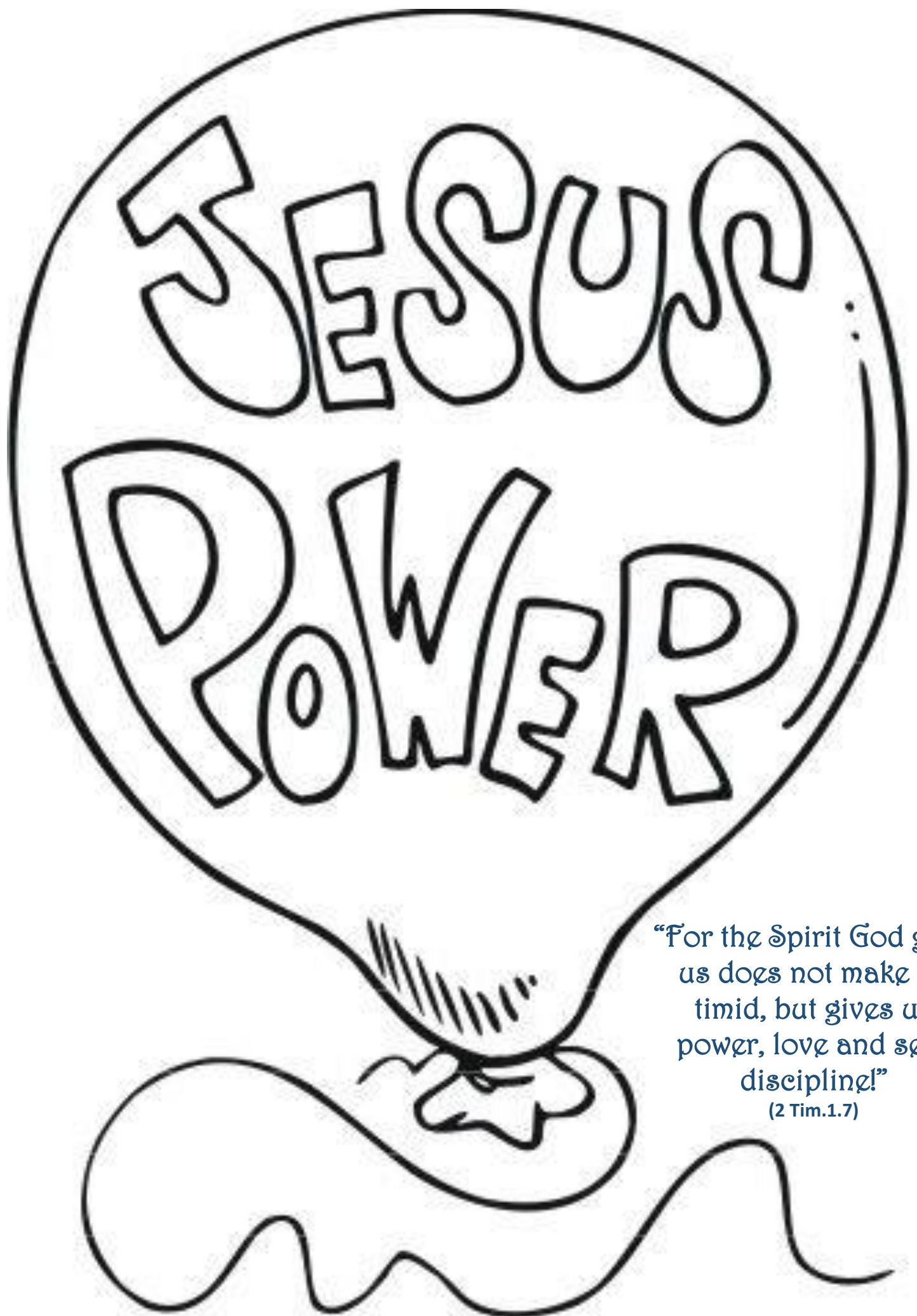
