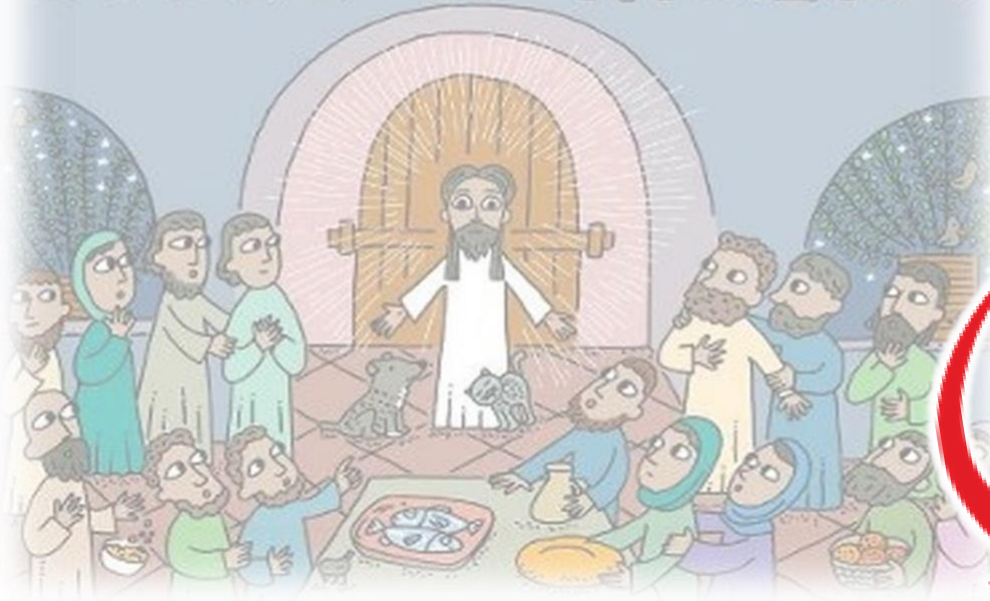

Jesus is risen!

That's what we're going to be looking at in today's worksheet.



The fact that Jesus was **raised from the dead**

Here's today's Bible passage

– just a single verse!

Paul wanted to make sure that Timothy would keep his eyes on Jesus always.

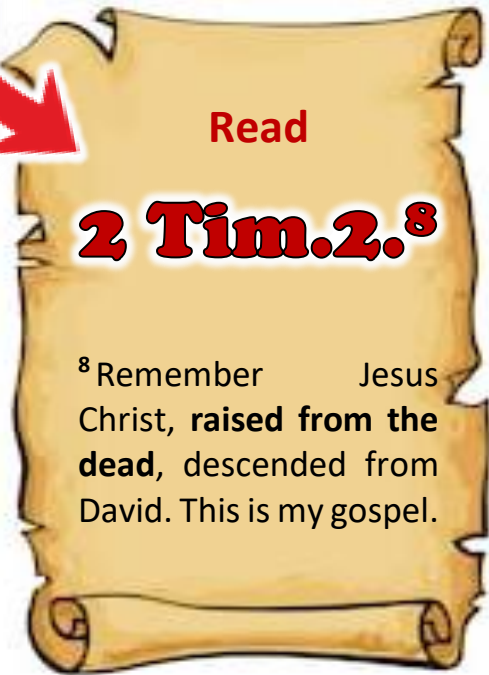
Remember Jesus! was his message.

What he does in v.8 is set out 3 important and basic truths about Jesus to help Timothy understand who Jesus is, what He's done and why He matters.

Here are the three important truths about Jesus –

- Jesus is **the Christ**
- Jesus is **raised from the dead**
- Jesus is **descended from David**

It's the second of these that this worksheet concentrates on

7 important truths follow from the fact that Jesus was raised from the dead!

7 in the Bible is often used to suggest completeness or perfection: like the 7 days of creation, or the way that 7 colours combine to make up a complete rainbow

Sometimes people try and remember the colours by turning the first letter of each of the colours into a sentence. One of the traditional ways of doing this is the following sentence –

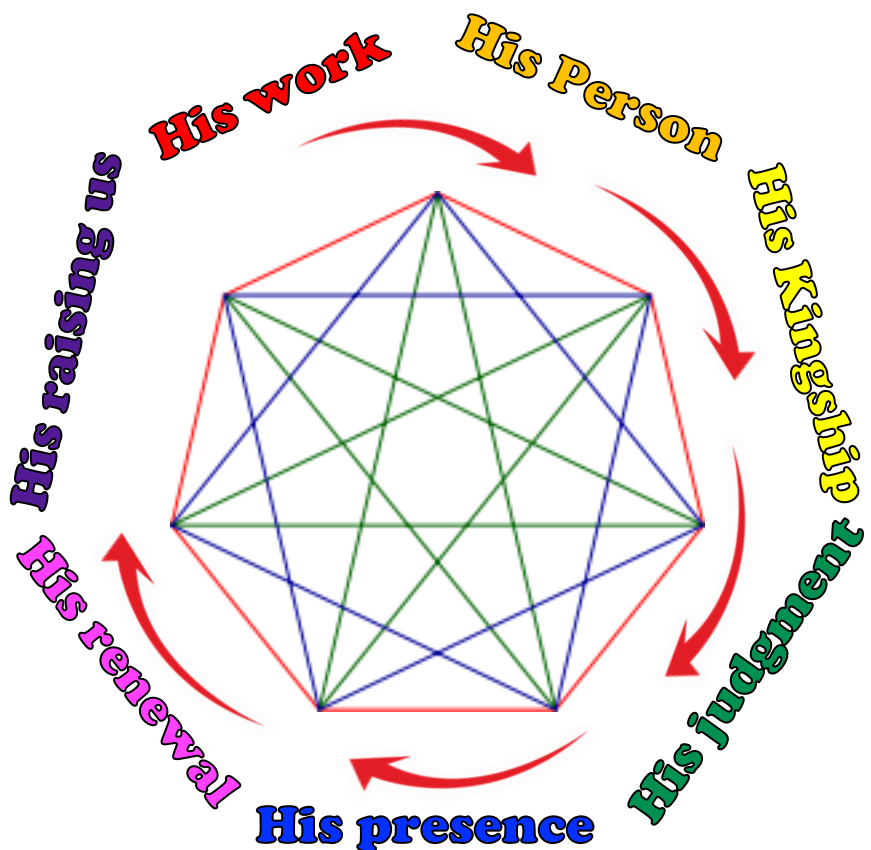
“Richard Of York Gave Battle in Vain”

That sentence is said to refer to a battle which took place in 1460 when the Duke of York (who was called Richard) was defeated and died at the battle of Wakefield.

Here are the 7 ways in which Jesus being raised from the dead changes everything!



His work

Jesus being raised from the dead means that what He was accomplishing for us when He died on the cross has been completed.

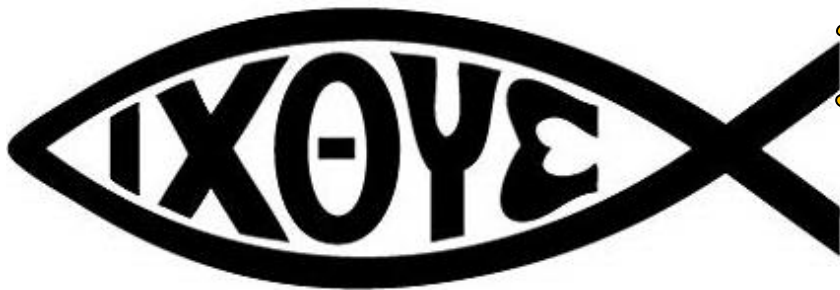

His Person

The fact that Jesus was raised from the dead confirms that He is indeed .. well,

God!

The early Christians often used the picture of a fish as a sign of their trust in Jesus.

The Greek word for a fish is I-CH-TH-U-S and they were able to put a word to each of the letters to say who Jesus is.

Here’s what the letters were used to mean

I	Jesus (Jesus)
CH	Christos (Christ)
TH	Theou (of God)
U	Uios (Son)
S	Soter (Saviour)

Putting them all together the letters of the Greek word for fish spelled out this message –

Jesus Christ, Son of God, Saviour

His Kingship

Jesus being raised from the dead didn't simply make clear who Jesus is.



It made clear the position He now has.

He's the King!
In charge of all the world.

The earliest Christian statement of their message was simply this: Jesus is Lord!

His judgment

When Paul had been in Athens, this is what he'd explained to people there

Read

Acts 17.31

He has set a day when He will judge the world with justice by the Man He has appointed. He has given proof of this to everyone by raising Him from the dead

Everyone will have to appear before Jesus one day. He will judge the world. For those who've trusted in Him all the wrong things in our lives have been covered by what He did for us in His death and resurrection.

Here's another important Bible verse for you to think about.



Jesus promised that He would come by His Holy Spirit to live with, and *in*, those who trusted in Him.

And the Holy Spirit is mighty! Mighty enough to raise Jesus from the dead: He can make us new too!

His raising us!

When God raised Jesus from the dead He made it clear that He's quite able to raise the dead ..

.. and that He will one day do just that.

Jesus promised that all who trust in Him will be raised to life again at the end of time.



Here's a verse from another of Paul's letters –

“we know that the one who raised the Lord Jesus from the dead will also raise us with Jesus and present us with you to himself”

[2 Corinthians 4.14]

right!

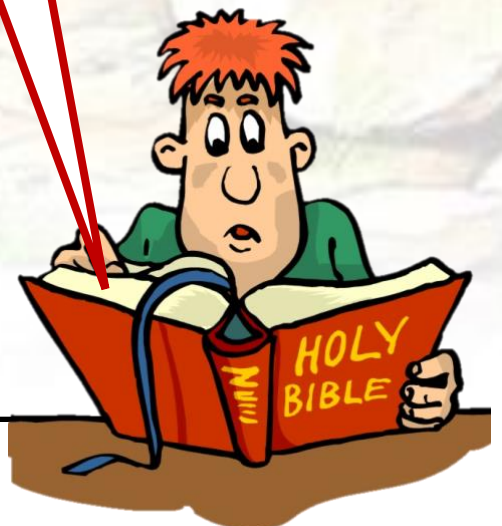

of a rugby ball



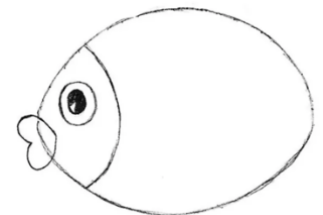

hand side



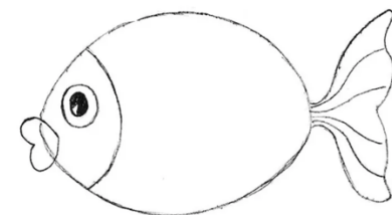
3)

shape of a heart



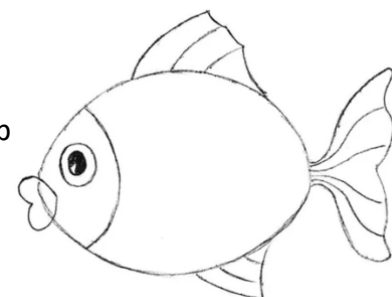

colour it in



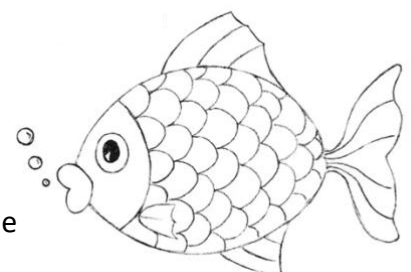
5)

bubbles too!

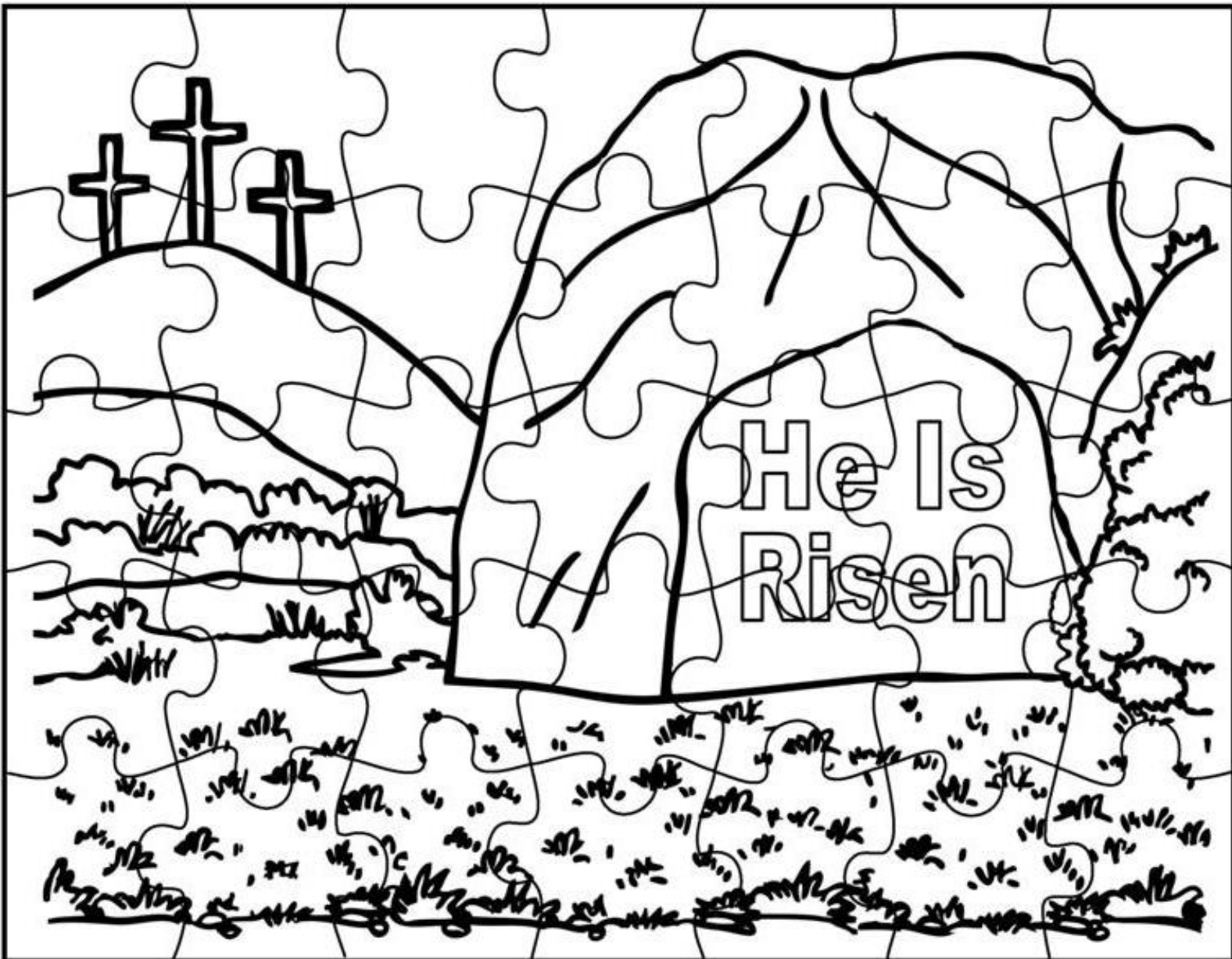
