

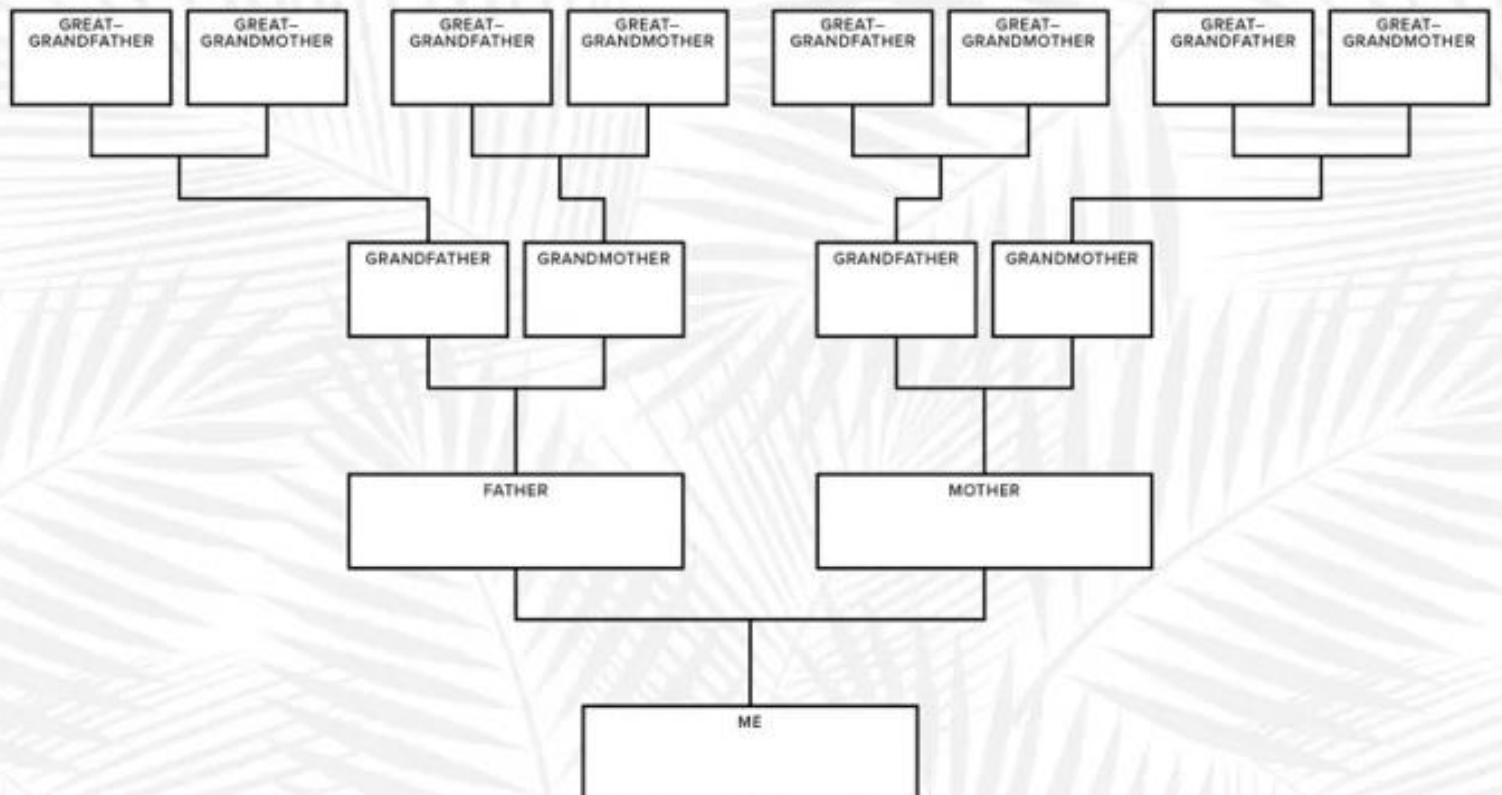

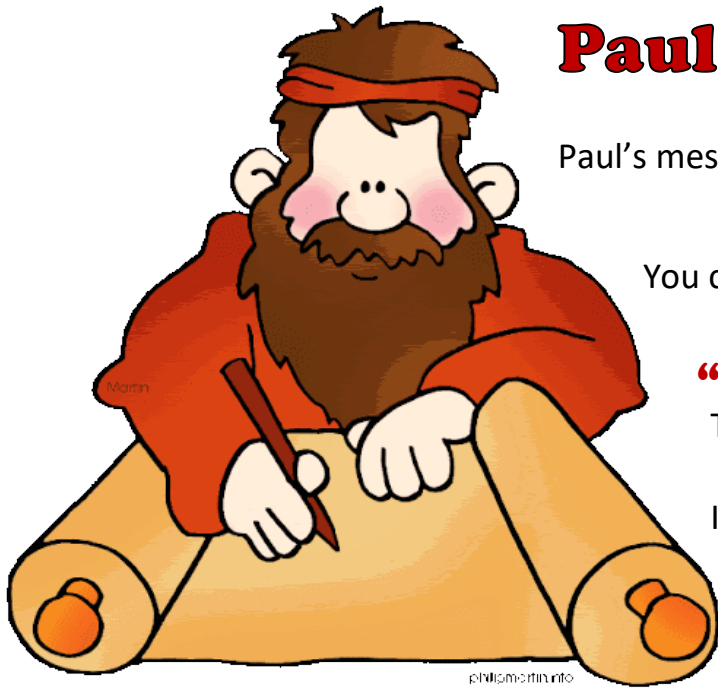

Paul's message

Paul's message was really quite simple.

You could put it in ONE word. **Jesus**

"Remember Jesus!"

That was basically his message.

If you asked him to explain why he made so much of Jesus, he'd have given you three reasons why Jesus is so important.

- Jesus is **the Christ**
- Jesus is **raised from the dead**
- Jesus is **descended from David**

It's the 3rd of these that this worksheet concentrates on

Here's what another writer in the Bible had to say ...

Read

Hebrews 2.14-18

¹⁴ Since the children have flesh and blood, **he too shared in their humanity** so that by his death he might break the power of him who holds the power of death – that is, the devil – ¹⁵ and free those who all their lives were held in slavery by their fear of death. ¹⁶ For surely it is not angels he helps, but Abraham's descendants. ¹⁷ For this reason he had to be made like them, **fully human in every way, in order that he might become a merciful and faithful high priest in service to God, and that he might make atonement for the sins of the people.** ¹⁸ Because he himself suffered when he was tempted, he is able to help those who are being tempted.

Notice the bits in **bold** type, where the writer is stressing that Jesus is fully human and one of us.

The writer of the letter wanted to help us understand why Jesus being fully human makes such a difference.

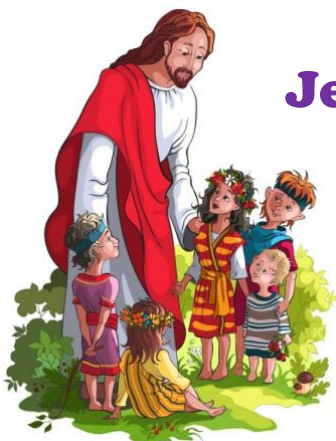


2 Sam. 7. 12-13

“The Lord declares to you that the Lord Himself will establish a house for you: ¹²when your days are over and you rest with your ancestors, I will raise up your offspring to succeed you, your own flesh and blood, and I will establish His kingdom. ¹³He is the one who will build a house for my Name, and I will establish the throne of His kingdom for ever.

This was the promise which the prophet Nathan brought to king David. Jesus is the ‘offspring’, David’s ‘own flesh and blood’ whose kingdom is now established for ever!

It's pretty special being part of **the royal family!**

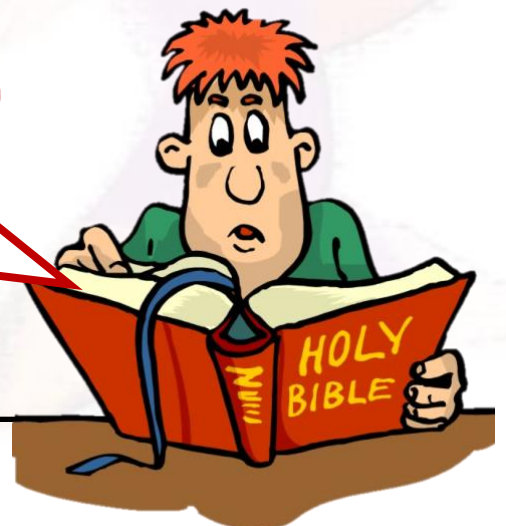

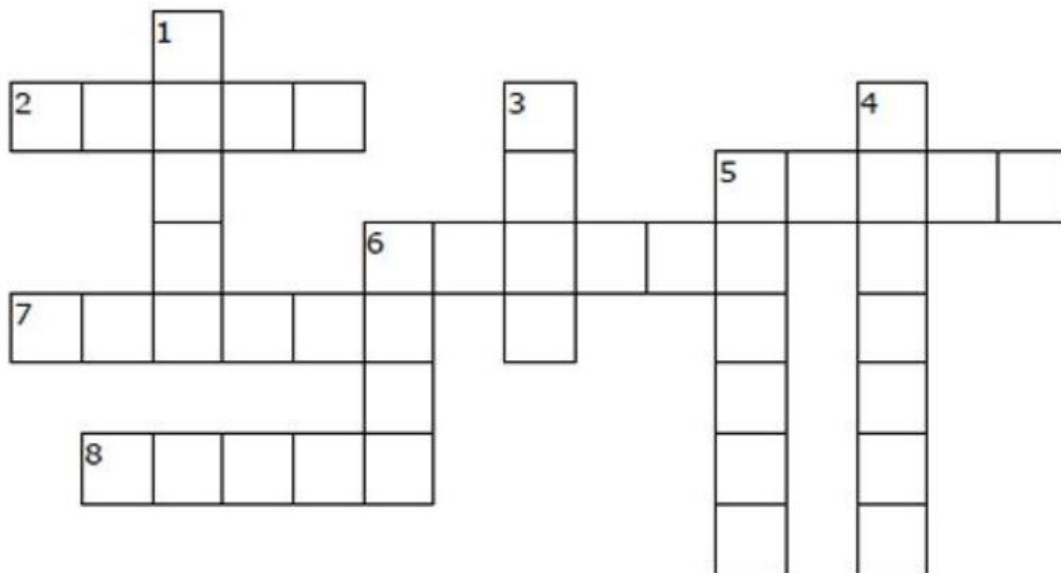
now try this crossword puzzle!
