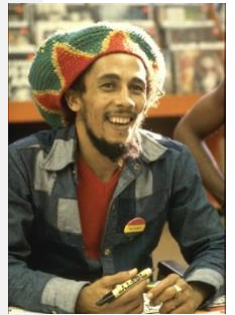

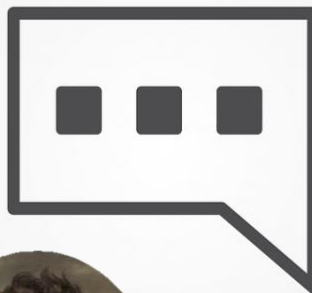

# final instructions

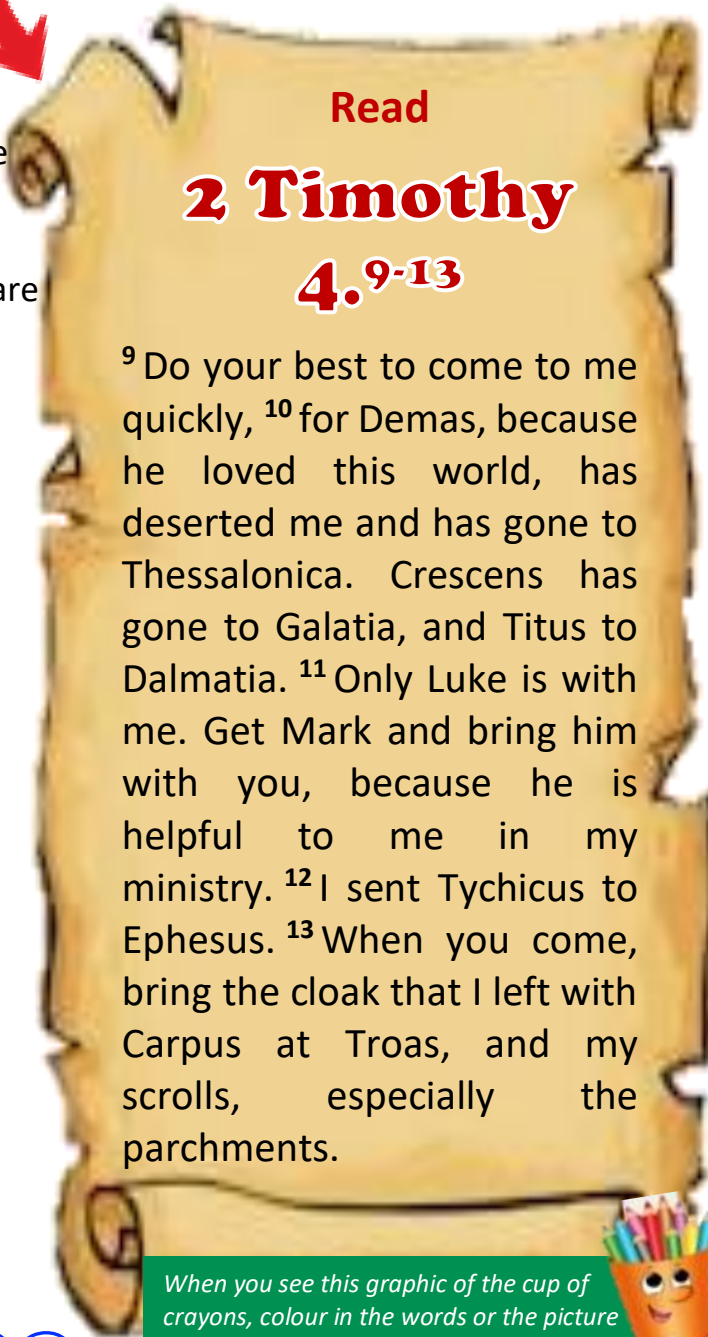

### 4.9-13

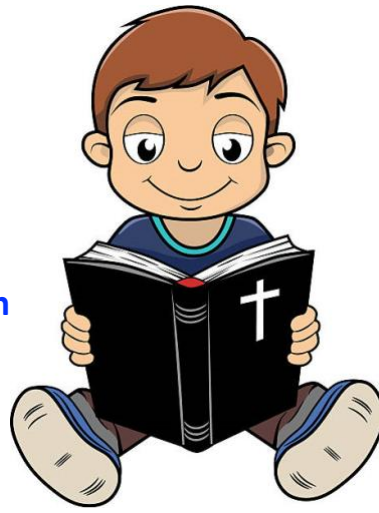

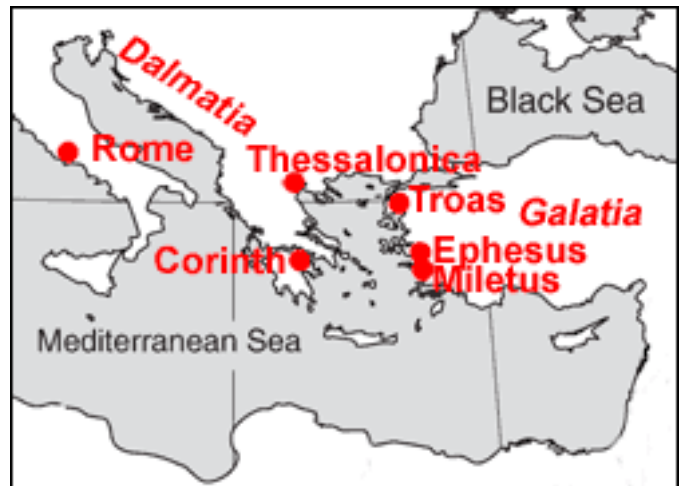

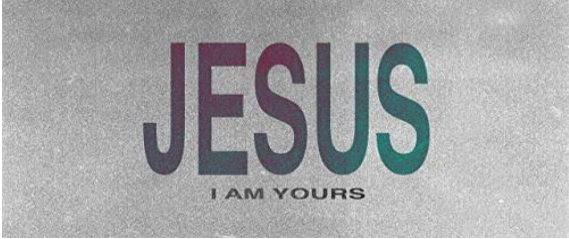


Paul and his friends were followers of Jesus.

I want to live my life for You.

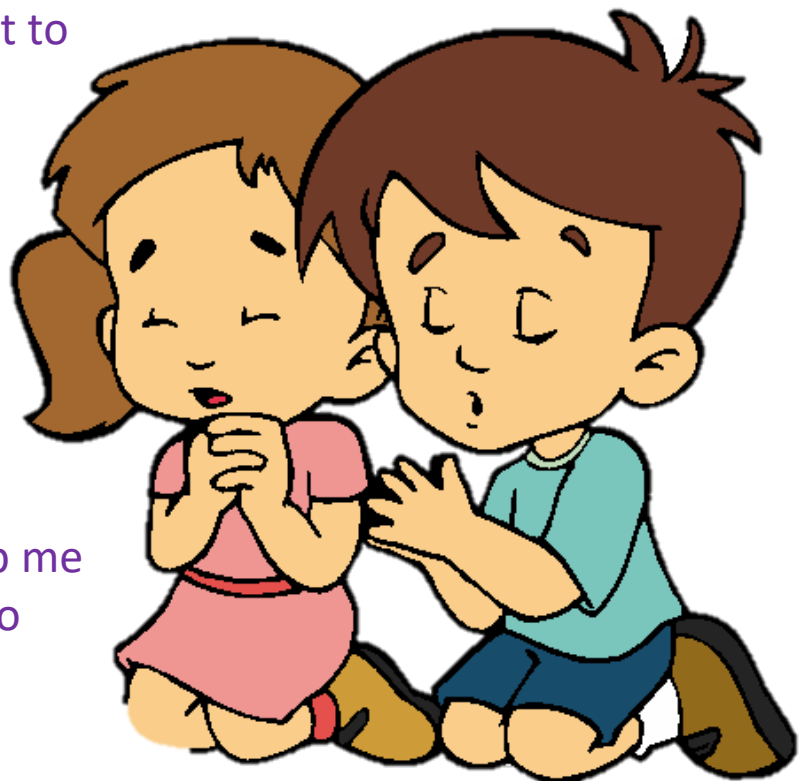
I'm glad that You were willing to go where Your Father sent You and that You came to rescue us.
