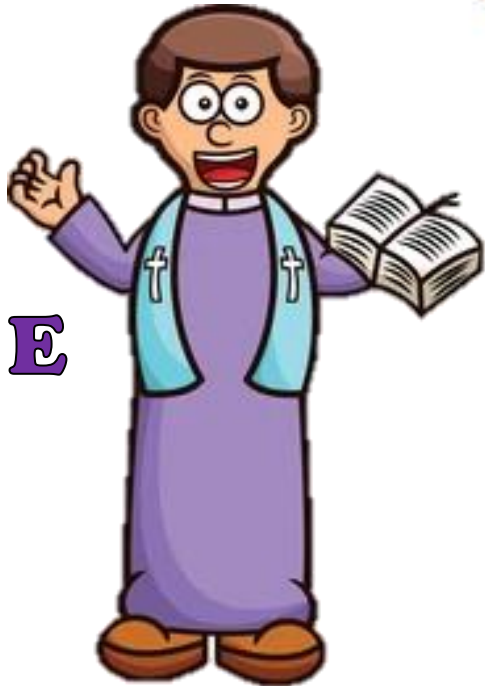

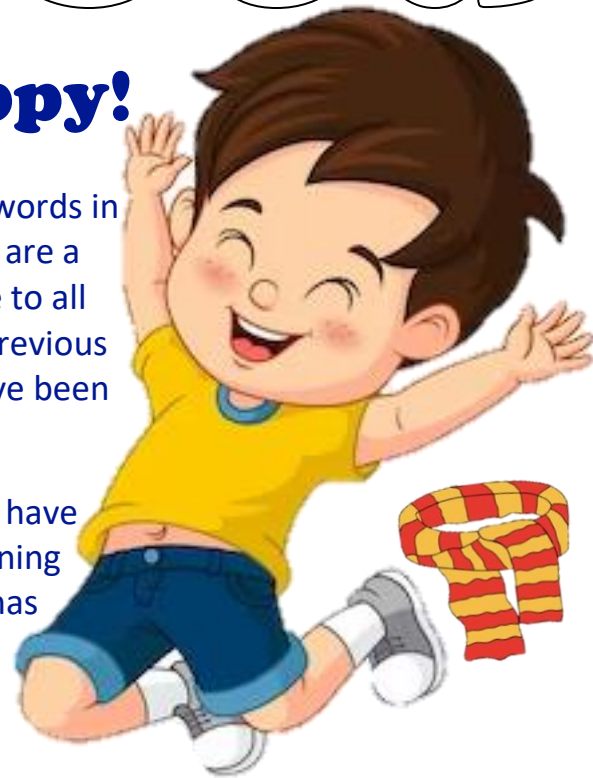

Why do we delight in God?

That's a good question!

Isaiah starts to explain why we knowing Jesus fills us with so much joy and makes us so excited and happy.

“For He has clothed me ..”

It's 'picture' language – it's not like He gives us a *literal* new set of clothes!

But in the same way as a new job will sometimes mean a person gets a new uniform to wear, so Jesus gives us a whole new life – and others are able to see from the way we live that a big change has taken place in us.

A new way of living for a whole new life which He gives us!

The garments of salvation .. a robe of His righteousness

What's meant by these phrases?

It's a way of reminding us (1) that we're put right with God (the robe of His righteousness): (2) that He gives us all we need to be able to stand against the powers of darkness: and (3) that He changes the way we behave towards others and the attitudes we have

For He has clothed me with garments of salvation and arrayed me in a robe of His righteousness, **as a bridegroom adorns his head like a priest, and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels.**

The last part of the verse explains that it's more than just a new life that Jesus gives us – it's a new life lived in a new relationship with Him!



The picture which Isaiah uses here is one which is often used in the Bible to help us understand the new relationship which we get to have with the Lord Jesus.

It's like being married!

He loves His people. He looks after them, serves them, does whatever's needed to make sure they enjoy life to the full and grow to their full potential!

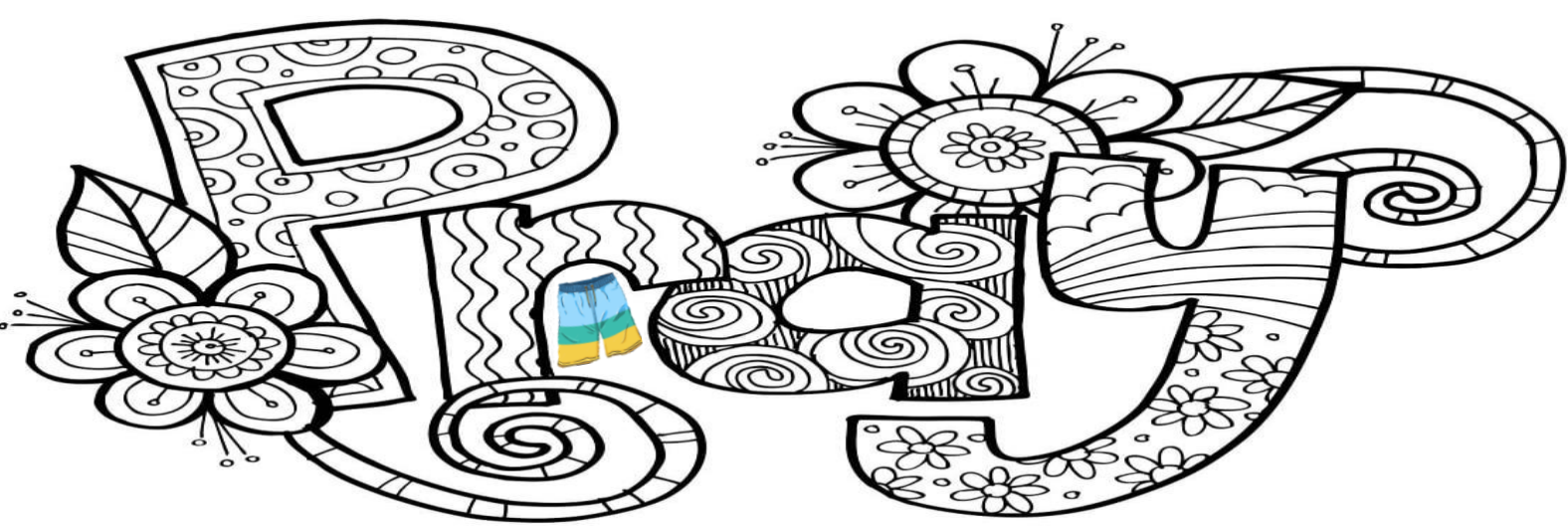

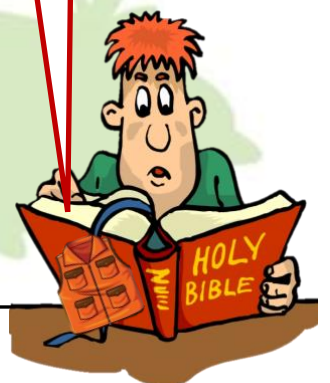
