Read  
**Genesis 2**  
verses 8-15

<sup>8</sup> Now the Lord God had planted a garden in the east, in Eden; and there he put the man he had formed.

.....

<sup>10</sup> A river watering the garden flowed from Eden; from there it was separated into four headwaters.

<sup>11</sup> The name of the first is the Pishon; it winds through the entire land of Havilah, where there is gold. <sup>12</sup> (The gold of that land is good; aromatic resin and onyx are also there.)

<sup>13</sup> The name of the second river is the Gihon; it winds through the entire land of Cush.

<sup>14</sup> The name of the third river is the Tigris; it runs along the east side of Ashur.

And the fourth river is the Euphrates.

<sup>15</sup> The Lord God took the man and put him in the Garden of Eden to work it and take care of it.

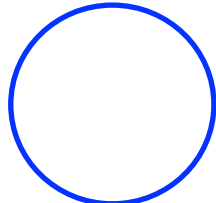
God had a special place for the first man and woman to live in.

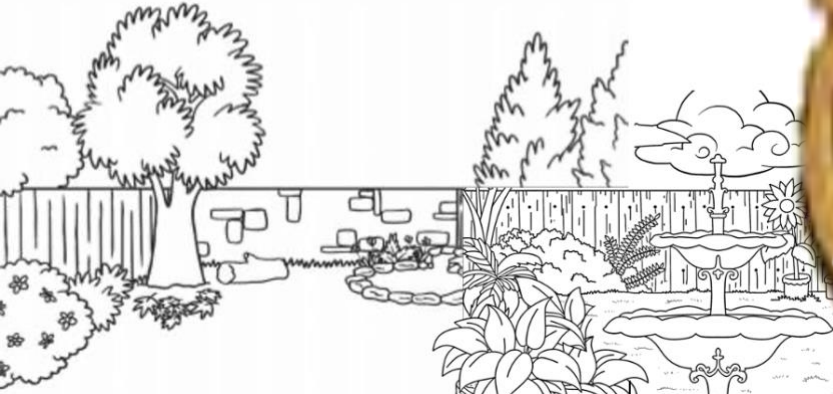

# the promise of heaven

Read  
**Revelation 21**  
verses 10-19

## God cares about where we live!

On the night before He was crucified, Jesus told His friends that He was going to prepare a place for them. ?

He was talking about heaven!  
And you're maybe wondering  
what heaven's like!

The last book in the Bible tells  
us a little bit of what it's like.

All the way through the Bible  
God gives us 'clues' as to what it's like.

It's a bit like the garden of Eden.

It's a bit like the land of Canaan – that 'good & spacious land' which He promised His people.



## Heaven will be great!

Try circling in the verses alongside those parts of the passage which tell us the following –

- Heaven is bright and shiny.

<sup>10</sup>And he carried me away in the Spirit to a mountain great and high, and showed me the Holy City, Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God. <sup>11</sup>It shone with the glory of God, and its brilliance was like that of a very precious jewel, like a jasper, clear as crystal. <sup>12</sup>It had a great, high wall with twelve gates, and with twelve angels at the gates. On the gates were written the names of the twelve tribes of Israel. <sup>13</sup>There were three gates on the east, three on the north, three on the south and three on the west. <sup>14</sup>The wall of the city had twelve foundations, and on them were the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.

<sup>15</sup>The angel who talked with me had a measuring rod of gold to measure the city, its gates and its walls. <sup>16</sup>The city was laid out like a square, as long as it was wide. He measured the city with the rod and found it to be 12,000 stadia in length, and as wide and high as it is long. <sup>17</sup>The angel measured the wall using human measurement, and it was 144 cubits thick. <sup>18</sup>The wall was made of jasper, and the city of pure gold, as pure as glass. <sup>19</sup>The foundations of the city walls were decorated with every kind of precious stone.

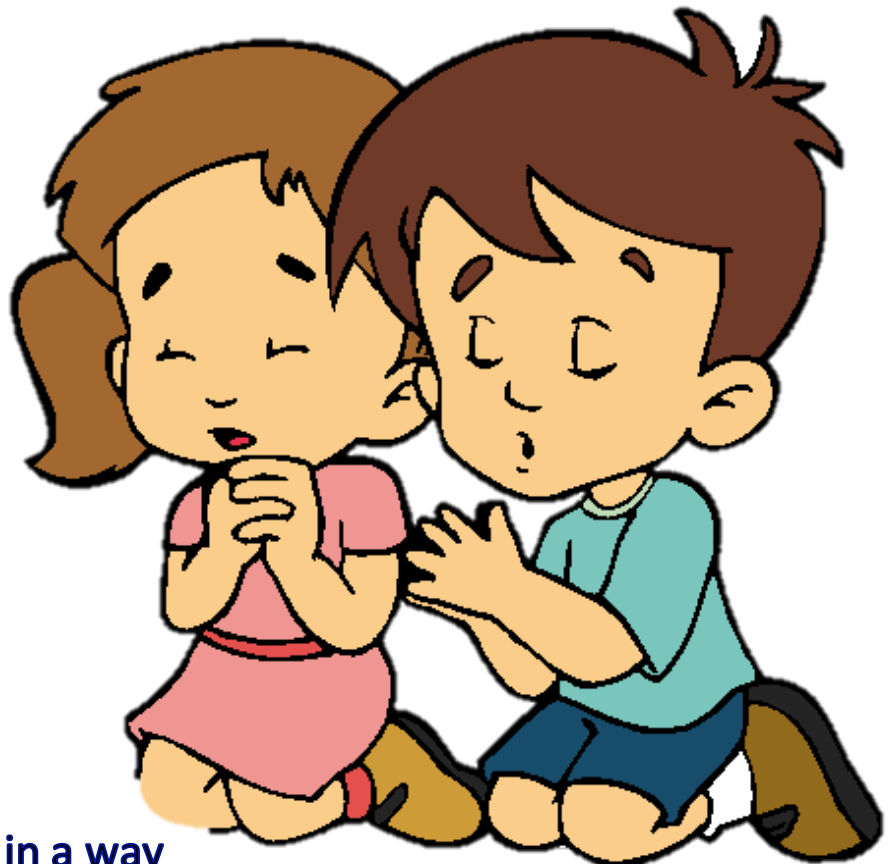

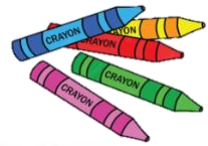
