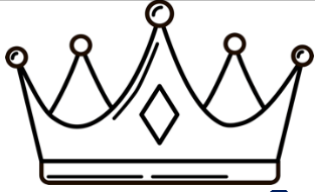


Tonight's

The prophet Isaiah was used by God, hundreds of years before Jesus was born, to tell the people about the King God had promised He would send. He described Him as the **Mighty God**.

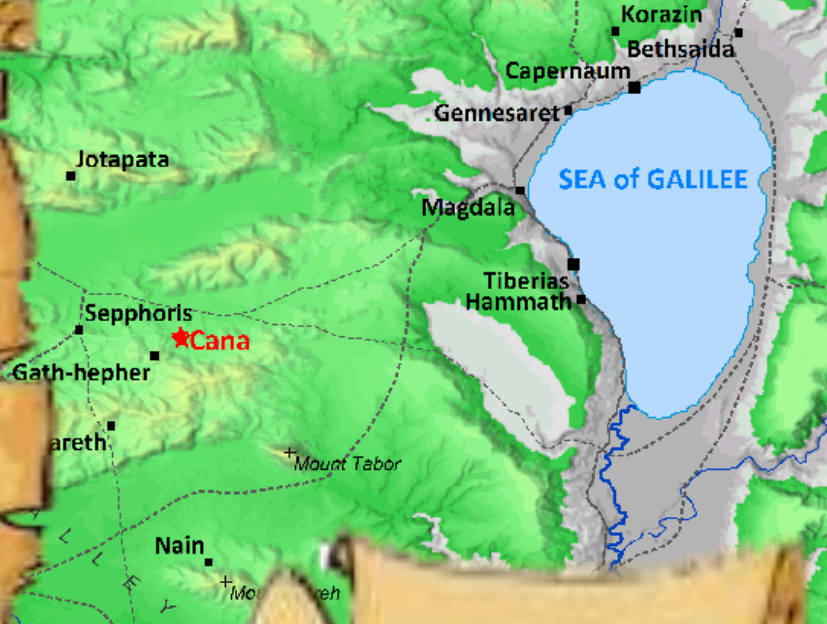


JESUS IS THE MIGHTY GOD

Read John 4 verses 46

46 Once more he visited Cana in Galilee, where he had turned the water into wine.

What happened at Cana?

You can read the story of what happened at Cana here  It was the first of what John (who tells the story) says are 'signs' that Jesus did.

As you're travelling along the road signposts will give you important information: when Jesus turned the water into wine He was telling you who He is and what He does.

The 2 pictures below are taken from the story of Jesus turning the water into wine. Can you spot the 8 differences between them?



A wedding took place at Cana in Galilee. Jesus' mother was there,² and Jesus and his disciples had also been invited to the wedding.³ When the wine was gone, Jesus' mother said to him, 'They have no more wine.'⁴ 'Woman, why do you involve me?' Jesus replied. 'My hour has not yet come.'⁵ His mother said to the servants, 'Do whatever he tells you.'

⁶ Nearby stood six stone water jars, the kind used by the Jews for ceremonial washing, each holding from eighty to a hundred and twenty litres.

⁷ Jesus said to the servants, 'Fill the jars with water'; so they filled them to the brim.⁸ Then he told them, 'Now draw some out and take it to the master of the banquet.' They did so,⁹ and the master of the banquet tasted the water that had been turned into wine. He did not realise where it had come from, though the servants who had drawn the water knew. Then he called the bridegroom aside¹⁰ and said, 'Everyone brings out the choice wine first and then the cheaper wine after the guests have had too much to drink; but you have saved the best till now.'

Jesus helps us with all our problems

By turning the water into wine at the wedding in Cana, Jesus had already shown that He is able to help us in all our problems and that He is indeed the **MIGHTY GOD**

Read John 4 verses 46-50

And there was a certain royal official whose son lay ill at Capernaum. ⁴⁷When this man heard that Jesus had arrived in Galilee from Judea, he went to him and begged him to come and heal his son, who was close to death.

⁴⁸ 'Unless you people see signs and wonders,' Jesus told him, 'you will never believe.'

⁴⁹ The royal official said, 'Sir, come down before my child dies.'

⁵⁰ 'Go,' Jesus replied, 'your son will live.'

Lessons for you to learn

LISTENING

Listen carefully to what the Bible has to teach you about Jesus – just as the man had kept his ears open!



Go to Jesus, just like the man did, tell Him what your problem is and ask Him to help you.

Trust the promises which Jesus has made. He **will** be with you and He **will** help you

The man took Jesus at his word and departed.

⁵¹ While he was still on the way, his servants met him with the news that his boy was living.

⁵² When he enquired as to the time when his son got better, they said to him, 'Yesterday, at one in the afternoon, the fever left him.'

⁵³ Then the father realised that this was the exact time at which Jesus had said to him, 'Your son will live.'

So **he and his whole household believed.**

⁵⁴ This was the second sign Jesus performed after coming from Judea to Galilee.

The man did what Jesus said. He trusted Him.

On his way back home (if you look at the map on page 2 you'll see it was quite a big distance he had to travel) his servants met him and told him his son was

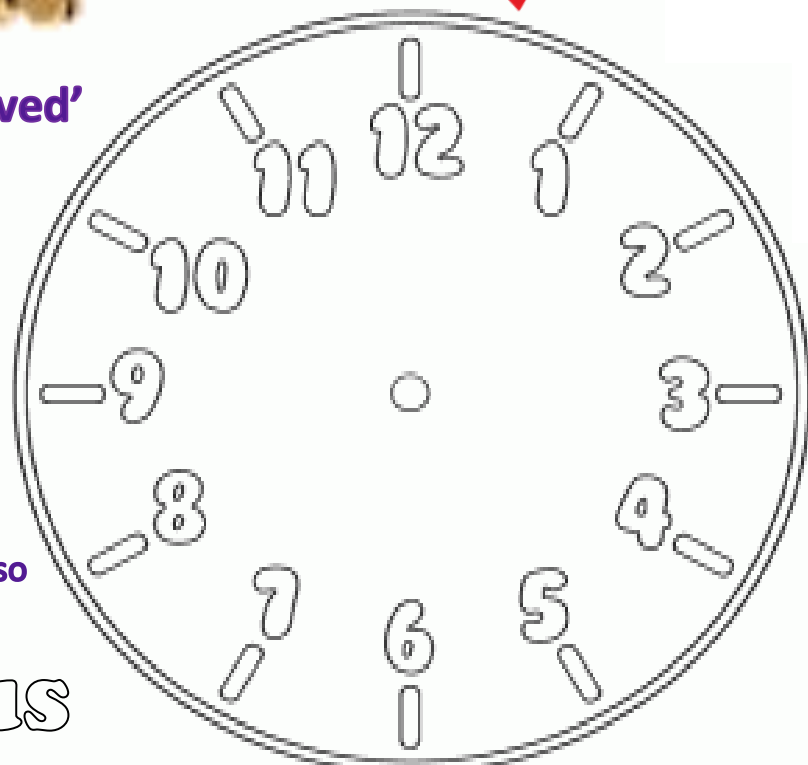
alive

Just as Jesus had promised!

When they checked on the time when the son had got well, it was the exact time when Jesus had told the man –

"Your son will live!"

Colour in the clock face below and draw in the hands of the clock to show what time it was that the man's son got well



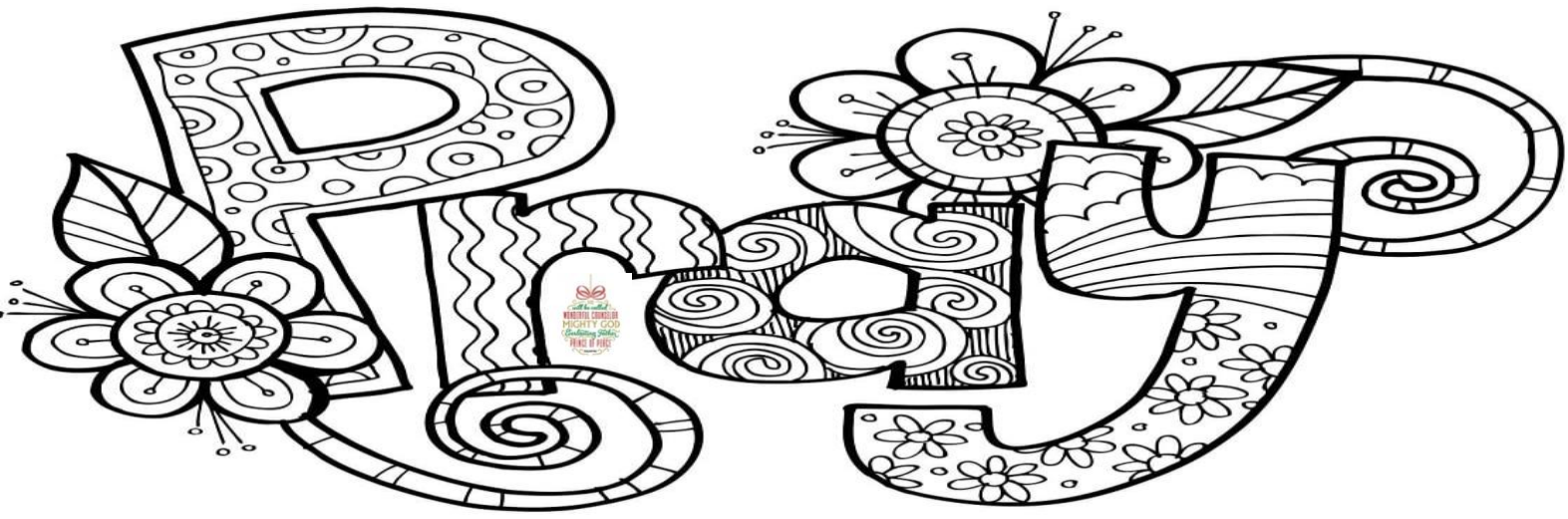
'He and his whole household believed'

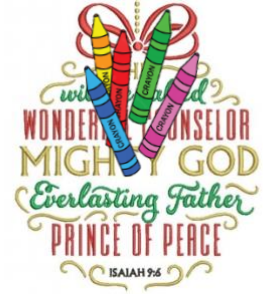
