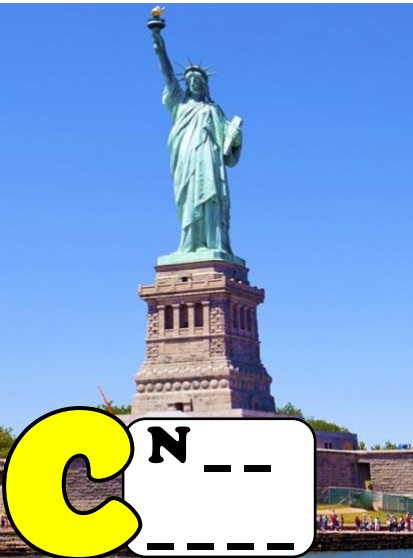

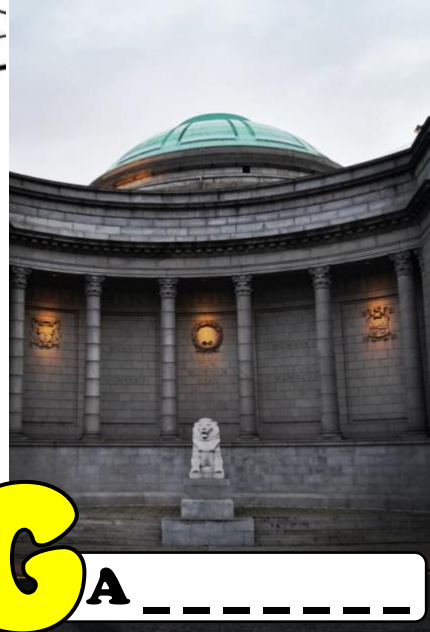

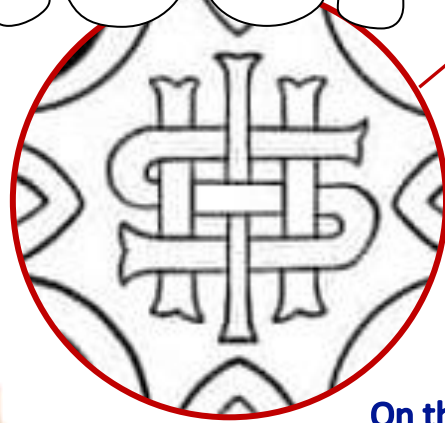

Read 2 Timothy 2 verses 8-13

⁸ **Remember** Jesus Christ, raised from the dead, descended from David. This is my gospel, ⁹for which I am suffering even to the point of being chained like a criminal. But God's word is not chained. ¹⁰Therefore I endure everything for the sake of the elect, that they too may obtain the salvation that is in Christ Jesus, with eternal glory.

¹¹ Here is a trustworthy saying: If we died with Him, we will also live with Him; ¹² if we endure, we will also reign with Him. If we disown Him, He will also disown us; ¹³ if we are faithless, He remains faithful, for He cannot disown Himself.

On the front page of the worksheet, did you spot in the middle of the cross, what looks like the three letters – I H S – woven through each other?

You quite often see these three letters in old churches. They stand for three Greek words which mean simply –

JESUS OUR SAVIOUR

(Greek was the language which most folk spoke at the time when the early church started).

When you see these three letters on a cross (or wherever they might be in a church) they are a reminder to us about who Jesus is.

Colour in the three Greek words at the bottom of the page – and then see if you can copy the Greek writing in the box below!

God wants us always to remember who Jesus is – and what He has done for us.



The fish is another symbol the early church used as a reminder of Jesus. The word for fish in Greek is ichthus (5 letters – I CH TH U S) and each of the 5 letters stood for a word: JESUS / CHRIST / OF GOD / THE SON / SAVIOUR

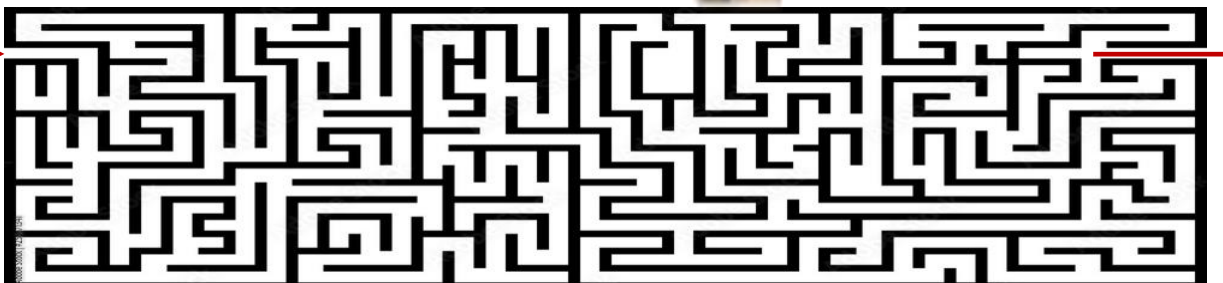
Victory in the place of failure

The last time the people had been at this place, Ebenezer, they had failed miserably (read the story in 1 Samuel 4).

They weren't right with God and they were no match for the Philistines.

In the place where they'd failed previously, now that they had got right with God, it was victory they experienced.

¹⁰ While Samuel was sacrificing the burnt offering, the Philistines drew near to engage Israel in battle. But that day the Lord thundered with loud thunder against the Philistines and threw them into such a panic that they were routed before the Israelites.

¹¹ The men of Israel rushed out of Mizpah and pursued the Philistines, slaughtering them along the way to a point below Beth Kar.

¹² Then Samuel took a stone and set it up between Mizpah and Shen.

He named it Ebenezer, saying, 'Thus far the Lord has helped us.'

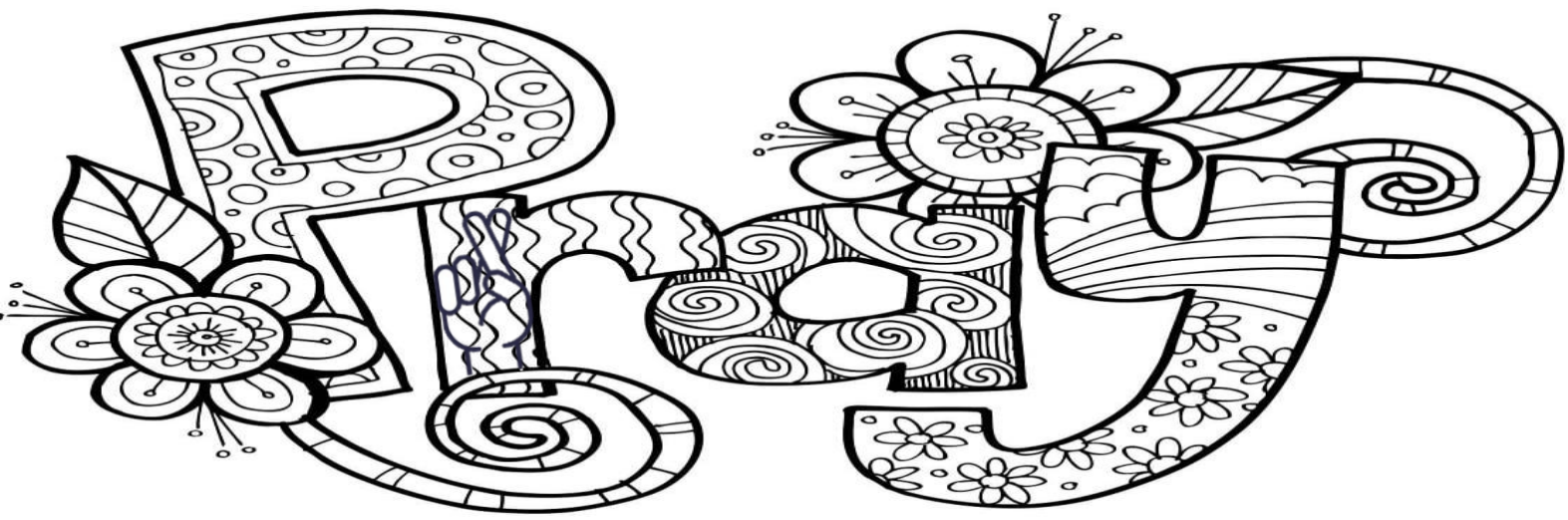

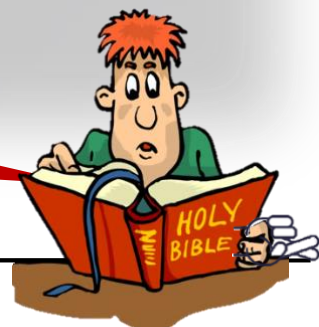
