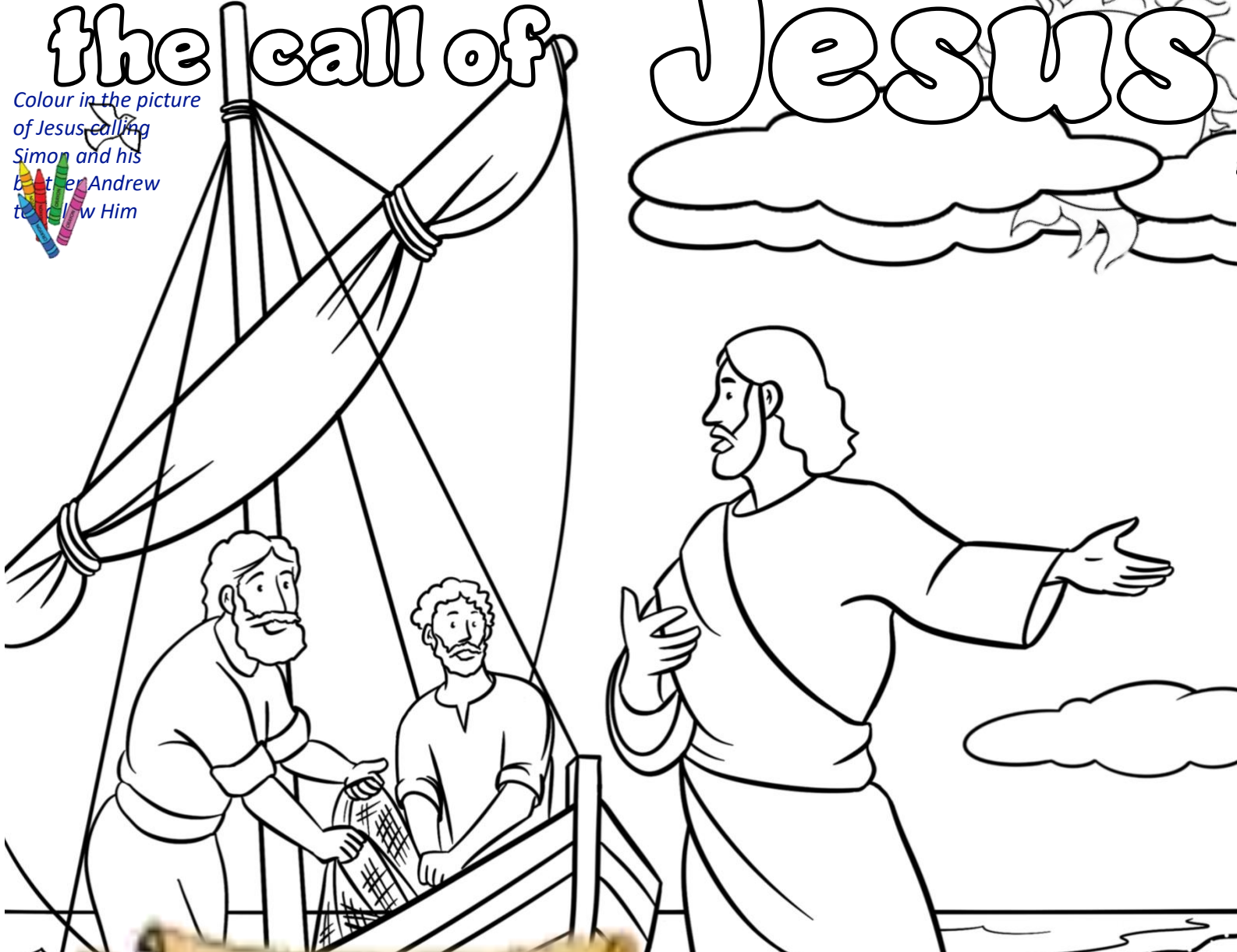

# If Saul was going to do the job for God, he would need God to change him!

Which is exactly what God did! He changed Saul's heart.

Jesus promised His followers that He would come and live in them by His Spirit: and that by His Spirit He would enable them to do what He called them to do!

And that's exactly what happened as well – Saul found himself in among the prophets, speaking as he'd never done before!

God wanted Saul to know that he could rely always on the help of God's Spirit.

And He wanted other people to know that Saul wouldn't be serving the Lord in his own strength, but in God's!

# JESUS WILL HELP YOU TOO

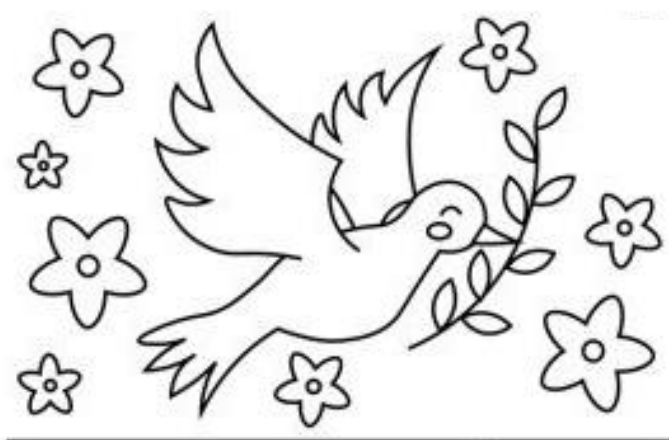
If you're going to follow Jesus and serve Him, then you then, like Saul, you'll definitely need His help!

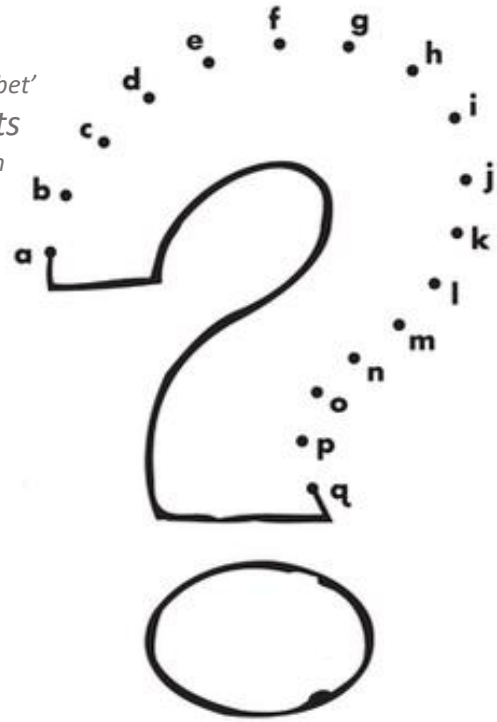

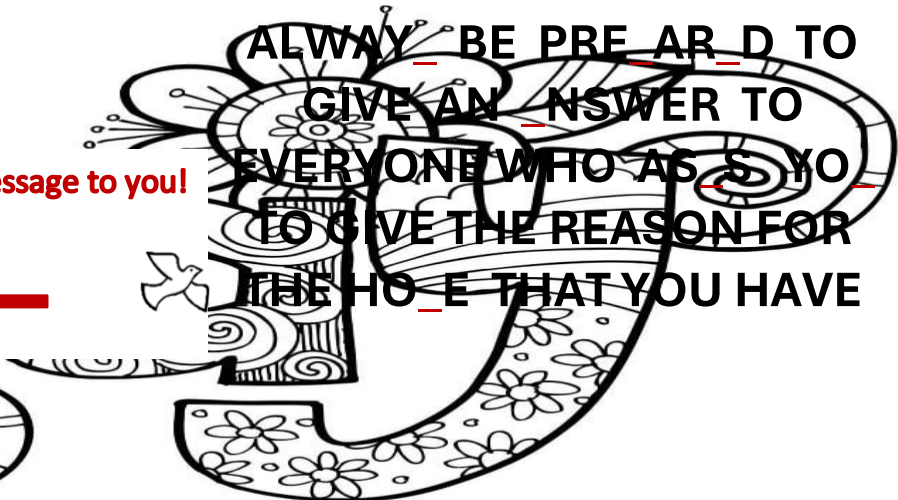

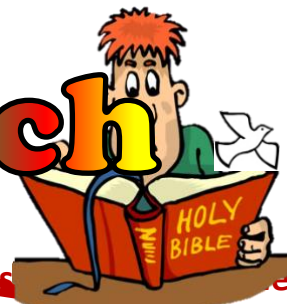

In this Wordsearch you're looking for the names of the 12 disciples who were called to be His 'apostles': He had a job for them to do, same as He calls you to share in His work.

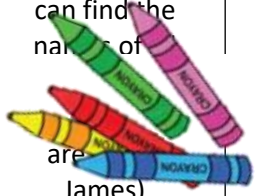
