

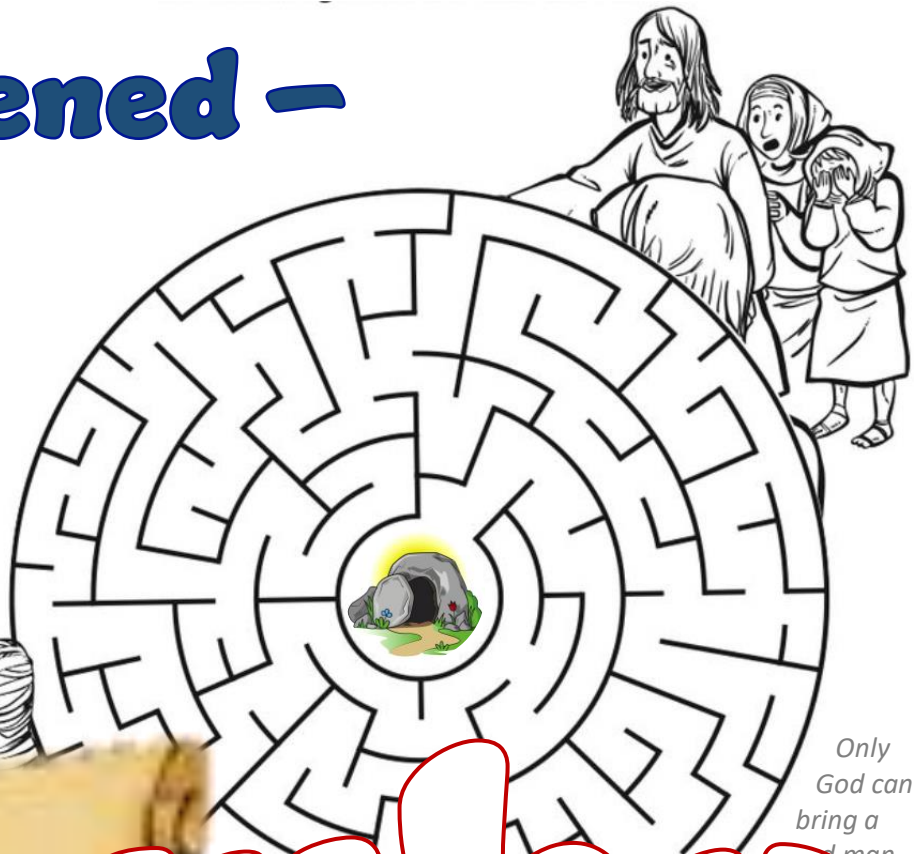
A man who lived there saw Saul prophesying with all the other prophets and wondered **who** was the cause of all that was happening.

# What happened – only God could do!

The only way people could explain the things that Jesus did was by recognising that He is the Son of God – fully divine!



The early Christians used a fish as a secret sign. The letters of the Greek word for fish spelled –

- I Jesus
- X Christ
- Θ of God
- Υ the Son
- Σ Saviour

How did He get the life out of the tomb?

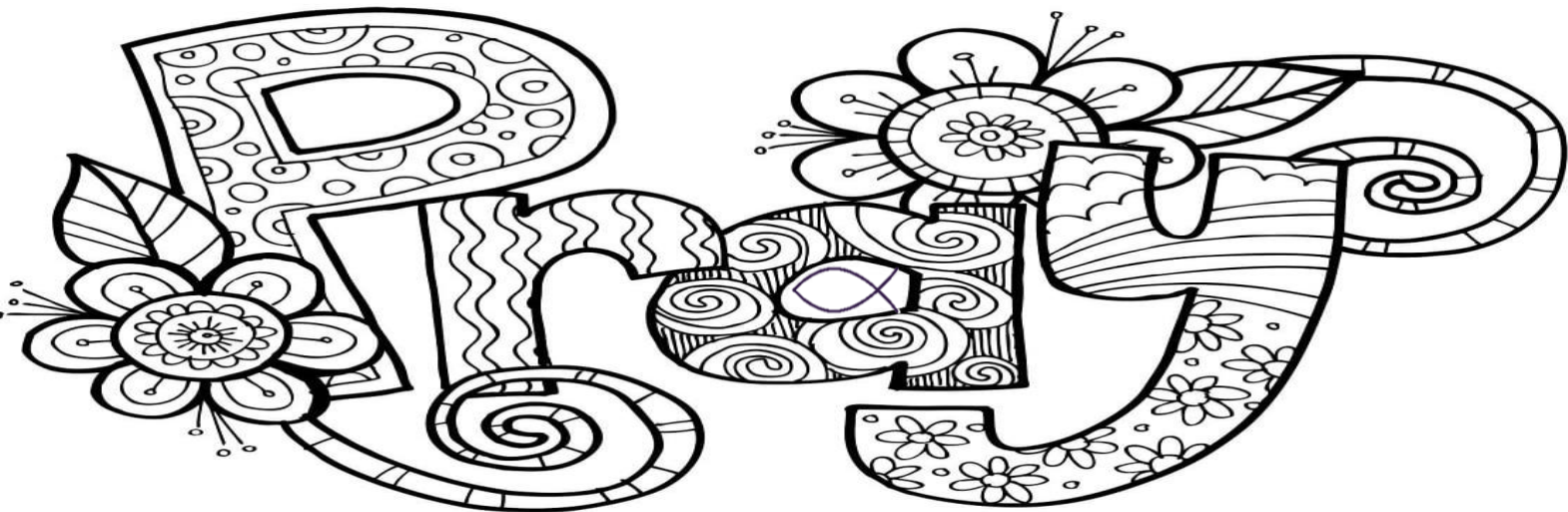
Something big was going on – much bigger than even Saul could understand at the time!

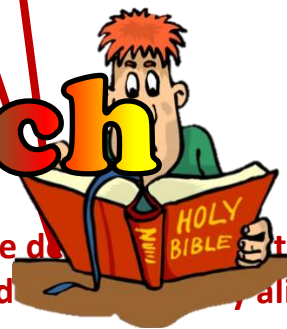
