come now before Him and rejoice.**

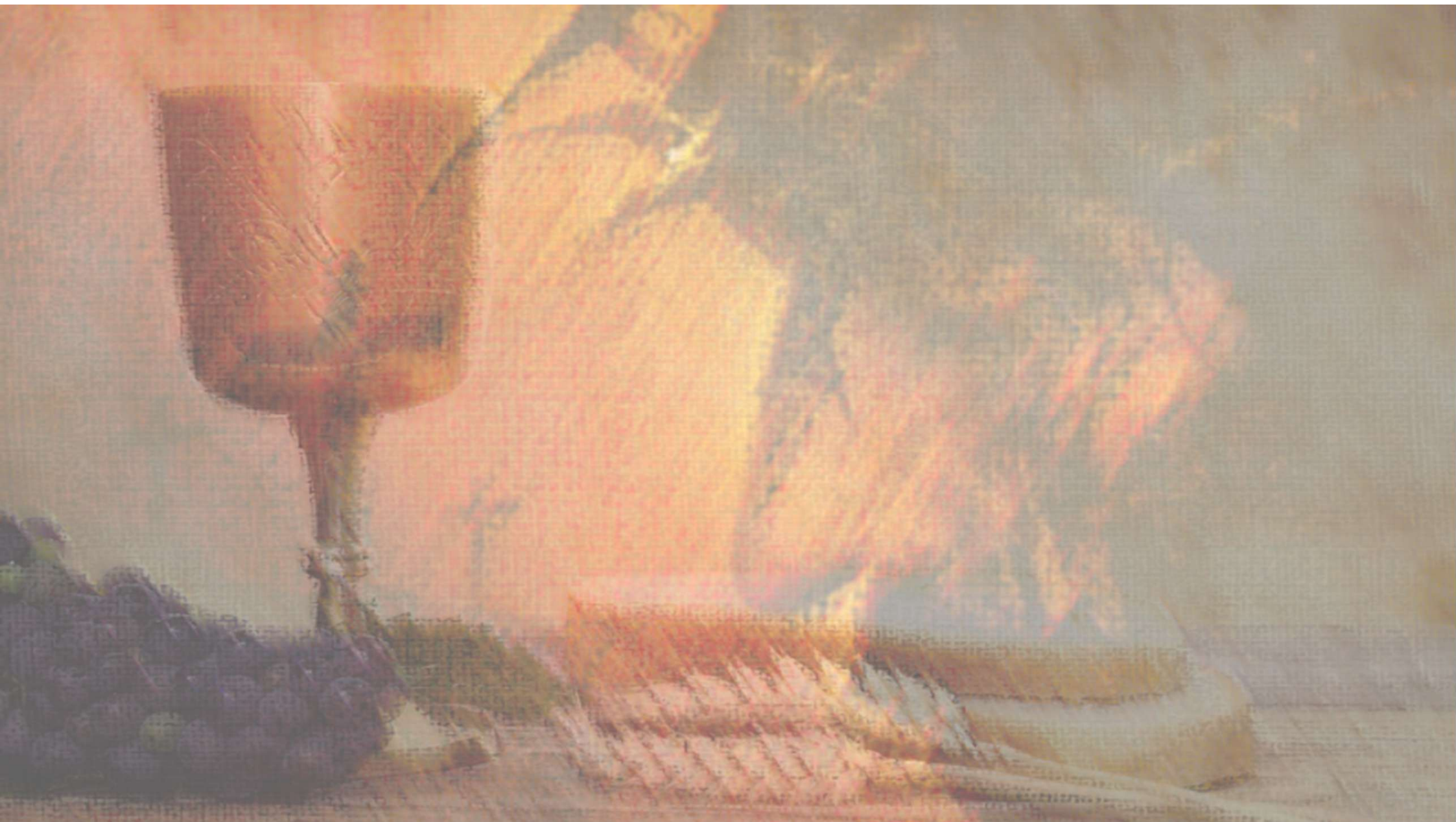
**Know that the Lord is God indeed;
